## **Fathers Day Fold Card**



## **Supplies:**

- Stamp: Crazy About You (P 137137/CM 138859/WM 138856)
- Dies: Hello You Thinlits (137363), Stars Framelits (133723)
- STAMP & DIE BUNDLE: Crazy About You Bundle (P 138873/CM 139325/WM 139324)
- Cardstocks: Whisper White (100730), Soft Suede (115318), Cherry Cobbler (119685)
- Ink: Soft Suede (126978)
- DSP: Regals DSP Stack (138436)
- Embossing Folders: Lucky Stars (135817), Boho Chic (138286)
- Punch: Banner Triple (138292)
- Misc: Regals Enamel Dots (141681), Linen Thread (104199), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

## **Cutting Measurements:**

- Card base: Soft Suede 8" x 4 1/4" scored at 5 1/2" & folded
- Background DSP on card base: Crushed Curry Script from Regals Stack DSP 5 ¼" x 4"
- Embossed mat on side flap: Soft Suede 4" x 2 ½"
- Fold out layer: Cherry Cobbler 8 ½" x 3 ½' scored at 4 ¼" & folded
- Mat on base of fold out layer Whisper White 4" x 3 ¼"
- Embossed mat on front of fold out layer Whisper White 4" x 3 ¼"
- Banner tags Striped DSP 3 ¼" x 1", Soft Suede 3 ½" x ½", Fathers Day 2 ½" x ½"

## Instructions - working from base upwards:

- 1. Adhere the Crushed Curry script DSP to the Soft Suede base
- 2. Adhere the Cherry Cobbler fold out layer on top of that & add the white mat
- 3. Emboss the Soft Suede side flap layer using Lucky Stars Embossing Folder and adhere in place
- 4. Emboss the White top layer using Boho Chic Embossing Folder cut out tags from Regals Stack DSP & strip of Soft Suede cardstock and shape ends using Banner Triple Punch adhere in place & wrap around a piece of Linen Thread adhere to front of the fold out layer
- 5. Stamp Fathers Day using Suede ink & a stamp from Crazy About You onto White cardstock and shape as above
- 6. Die cut the word 'happy' using a die from Hello You Thinlits & use Glue Pen to attach to card front
- 7. Decorate using die cut stars using the small die from Stars Framelits and elements from Regals Enamel Dots
