Spooky Fun meets Sheltering Tree Card



Supplies:

Stamps: Sheltering Tree (137163), Spooky Fun (142236)
Dies: Banners Framelits (132173)
Inks: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Basic Gray (140932), Pumpkin Pie (126945)
Cardstocks: Basic Gray (121044), Basic Black (121045), Whisper White (100730)
DSP: Halloween Night (142022)
Glitter Paper: Pumpkin Pie Glimmer (142029)
Bakers Twine: Halloween Night (142027)
Misc: Blender Pens (102845), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Basic Gray 4 ¼" x 11" scored at 5 1/2"
- Orange Layer: Pumpkin Pie 3 ¾" x 5"
- Black Layer: Basic Black 3 5/8" x 4 7/8"
- Stamped layer: Whisper White 3 ¾" x 3 ¼"

Instructions:

- 1. Adhere Pumpkin Pie layer to card base & adhere Basic Black layer on top of that
- 2. Stamp the tree onto the white layer and wrap around a piece of Bakers Twine, securing with tape on the back
- 3. Stamp the pumpkin, color using ink & a blender pen or your choice of coloring medium & cut out using sharp Paper Snips
- 4. Stamp the sentiment & spider on two scraps and shape using banner dies trim to size adhere the spider banner to the card using Snail and the sentiment & pumpkin using pieces of Dimensionals
- 5. Use banner shaped dies to shape the patterned/glitter papers and position them in place on the black mat when you are happy with their positions, adhere in place using glue dots
- 6. Adhere the stamped layer in place on top and there you have one cute but spooky card!
