

Floral Die Cut Glitter Card



Supplies:

Stamp: Builder Birdcage (142891)

Glitter Paper: 6" x 6" Glimmer Paper Assortment (143831) – FREE ITEM!

Dies: Stylish Stems Framelits (142750), Magnetic Platform (130658), Big Shot (143263)

Punch: Banner Triple (138292)

Cardstocks: Sweet Sugarplum (141418), Crumb Cake (120953), Whisper White (100730)

Ink: Tip Top Taupe (138325)

Misc: Mini Glue Dots (103683), Dimensionals (104430), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Sweet Sugarplum 4 ¼" x 11" - scored at 5 ½"
- Layer: Whisper White 5 ¼" x 4"
- Strip: Crumb Cake 7/8" x 4"

Instructions:

1. Take the white layer and place into your Big Shot with the large flower die positioned at the top – use the Magnetic Platform underneath your cutting pad to hold it perfectly in place. Run through your Big Shot and repeat for the lower flower
2. Cut two pink (Sweet Sugarplum) pieces of glitter paper sized to cover the flower die cuts – adhere with Mini Glue Dots to the back of the layer – attach to your card base using Snail adhesive and Mini Glue Dots as required
3. Take your Crumb Cake strip and shape one end using the Triple Banner Punch (or cut that V shape with sharp scissors) – stamp your words onto it, trim to size and add to your card using Dimensionals
4. Die cut three large leaves and one small leaf from the green glitter paper (Mint Macaron) and add to your card using a glue pen
5. And there you have a beautiful, sparkly card ready for giving 😊
