



“She Shed” Treat Box

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: At Home With You Photopolymer Stamp Set (143681)
- Inks: Early Espresso Classic Stampin' Pad (126974), Basic Black Archival Stampin' Pad (140931), Stampin' Write Markers
- Card Stock: Crumb Cake 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock (120953), Early Espresso 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock (119686)
- Designer Paper: Wood Textures Designer Series Paper Stack (144177)
- Paper Basics: Watercolor Paper (122959), Window Sheets (142314)
- Accessories: Gold Binder Clips (141673), Berry Burst 1/2" Finely Woven Ribbon (144133)

- Tools: Gift Bag Punch Board (135862), Simply Scored Scoring Tool (122334), At Home Framelits Dies (143727), Ticket Tear Border Punch (143718), Big Shot Die-Cutting Machine (143263)
- Miscellaneous: At Home With You Photopolymer Bundle (145351), Tear & Tape (138995)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Using your Simply Scored Scoring Tool score a piece of 8 1/2" x 11" Crumb Cake Card Stock on the landscape side (long side along the top) at 2 1/2", 5", 7 1/2" and 10".



2. Turn your Crumb Cake Card Stock on the portrait side (short side along the top) and score at 1 3/8", 6" and 8".



3. With the landscape side (long side along the top) line your score lines up with the Start Line on the Gift Box Punch Board and punch the notches on the bottom of the box. Snip off the end piece.



4. Flip your card stock around. To make a “milk carton” box use a ruler and stylus to make a triangle in the first and third sections of the upper sections.



5. Add Tear & Tape to the end flap, burnish your score lines and assemble your box.



6. From the At Home With You stamp set and Early Espresso Classic ink stamp the door on one of the patterns in the Wood Textures Designer Series Paper Stack. Cut the door and window out on a Big Shot with the At Home Framelits Dies.



7. Adhere a small piece of window sheet to the back of the window in the door.

8. From the At Home With You stamp set and Basic Black Archival Stampin' Pad stamp the wreath and flower pot on watercolor paper. Use Stampin' Write markers to color in the wreath and flower pot.



9. Add a piece of Early Espresso Card Stock to the front of the box. Adhere the door on top of the Early Espresso Card Stock. With Dimensionals add the wreath and flower pot. Cover the rest of the box with the coordinating Wood Textures Designer Series Paper.



10. Take a coordinating piece of Wood Textures Designer Series Paper and use the Ticket Tear Border Punch to punch both ends of the roof. Fold in half and lay on top of the box.



11. Add a Gold Binder Clip to the top of the box and then tie a bow with Berry Burst 1/2" Finely Woven Ribbon and use a glue dot to adhere the bow to the Gold Binder Clip. The Gold Binder Clip will keep the box closed.
