

Merry Mistletoe White Snow Scene Christmas Card



Supplies:

Stamps: Merry Mistletoe (CM 143655/WM 143650)

Cardstocks: Early Espresso (119686), Cherry Cobbler (119685), Whisper White (100730)

Glitter Paper: Dazzling Diamonds (135315)

Inks: Early Espresso (126974), Cherry Cobbler (126966)

Dies: Santa's Sleigh Thinlits (140278), Stitched Shapes (145372), Big Shot (143263)

Embossing Folder: Ruffled Dynamic (143699)

Punch: 1 ¼" Circle (119861)

Misc: Paper Snips (103579), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Early Espresso 8 ½" x 5 ½" - scored at 4 ¼"
- Red layer: Cherry Cobbler 4" x 5 ¼"
- White layer: Whisper White 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Use Snail adhesive to adhere the red layer to the card base
2. Use Early Espresso Ink to stamp the reindeer onto the lower right corner
3. Use the largest circle from Stitched Shapes Framelits Dies to die cut a white circle and then texture it using the Ruffled Dynamic Embossing Folder
4. Use the tree die from Santa's Sleigh Thinlits to die cut a glittered tree from Dazzling Diamonds Glitter Paper
5. Take both the dies you just created and position them on your card where you want them to be – I shaved off a little of the left side of the circle with my Paper Trimmer and also snipped a little off of the bottom of the tree trunk. When happy with their positions, adhere the circle in place with Snail and the tree over it with Dimensionals
6. Punch the moon using the 1 ¼" Circle Punch and add with Dimensionals
7. Stamp Merry Christmas with Cherry Cobbler Ink, fussy cut out with Paper Snips and use Dimensionals to add to the card base
8. Finally attach this layer to your card and there you have one elegant snow scene 😊
