

Tranquil Tulips Birthday Card



Supplies:

Stamps: Tranquil Tulips Host (143767)

Dies: Happy Birthday Thinlits (143700), Big Shot (143263)

Cardstocks: Berry Burst (144243), Lemon Lime Twist (144245), Early Espresso (119686), Whisper White (100730)

Specialty Paper: Window Sheets (142314)

Inks: Berry Burst (144083), Lemon Lime Twist (144086), Early Espresso (126974)

Misc: Paper Snips (103579), Glitter Enamel Dots (144200), Dimensionals (104430), Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Berry Burst 4 ¼" x 11" - scored at 5 ½"
- Green layer: Lemon Lime Twist 4" x 5 ¼"
- Brown layer: Early Espresso 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"
- White layer: Whisper White 3 5/8" x 4 7/8"
- Window Sheet layer: 3 5/8" x 4 7/8"

Instructions:

1. Cut the Early Espresso and Lemon Lime Twist layers and use Snail adhesive to adhere both to the Berry Burst card base
2. Using stamps from the set Tranquil Tulips and Berry Burst Ink, stamp the tulip shapes onto a piece of white cardstock – you need to stamp enough for 4 small flowers and 1 large flower – when dry, use Paper Snips to cut the flowers out
3. Take the two pieces for each flower and line them up – stamp the stamens using Early Espresso Ink onto the back piece and then adhere the front piece in place – repeat for the other 4 flowers
4. Place all flowers onto the white layer and when happy with the placement, stamp the stems using Lemon Lime Twist Ink and then adhere the flowers in place with Snail – then stamp the leaves
5. Attach this layer onto your card base and dot Glitter Enamel Dots around – I used 4 light green ones on my card
6. Add the window sheet onto this as follows – cut in half 2 Mini Glue Dots – take each half, roll into a ball and add to the top of each Glitter Enamel Dot – line up your Window Sheet and pop into place – the glue dots hold it nicely there
7. Die cut 'Happy Birthday' from Early Espresso cardstock and cut thin strips from the border piece around your sheet of Dimensionals – cut and use these thin strips to put on the back of your die cut – turn over and pop into place on to the window sheet
8. And there you have one beautiful fresh and vibrant Birthday card ready for giving 😊
