A Row of Tiny Treat Boxes filled with Holiday Nuggets & a Tea Light



Supplies:

Stamps: Merry Mistletoe (CM 143655/WM 143650)

Dies: Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Seasonal Layers Thinlits (143751), Big Shot (143263)

Embossing Folder: Softly Falling (139672)

Cardstocks: Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer (135315), Vellum (101856), Whisper White (100730), Cherry Cobbler (119685)

DSP: Be Merry (144111)

Inks: Early Espresso (126974), Garden Green (126973)

Punch: Decorative Ribbon Border (143721), 1/8" Circle (134365)

Ribbons: Whisper White Solid Bakers Twine (124262), Garden Green 3/8" Stitched Satin (144181)

Misc: Clear Tiny Treat Boxes (141699), Boxwood Wreaths (144176), Metallic Enamel Shapes (141678), Dimensionals

(104430), Glue Dots (103683), Tear & Tape (138995), Paper Snips (103579), Tea Light, Hershey Nuggets

Instructions:

- 1. Take 3 Clear Tiny Treat Boxes and pop into shape. Cut three 2" x 2" squares of Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer Paper and adhere one to the inside base of each box to create a sparkly snowy floor
- 2. Take 2 of the boxes you are going to do the same to each of them. Cut two pieces of Vellum cardstock to measure 2" x 6" emboss both with the Softly Falling Embossing Folder to give a snowy look pop each into your scoring tool with the long edge at the top and score at 2" and 4" fold along those score lines.
- 3. Take the first box making sure that you have the lid fold line facing you (you want the flap where the lid closes & locks at the back for prettiness reasons ③) pop your snowy vellum backdrop so that the back & sides are covered and the front is the window. Repeat for the second box.
- 4. To make the gifts take 4 Hershey Nuggets and use tape to hold them together. Cut two strips of DSP to be 1" x 6" and wrap each strip around the Nuggets in a criss cross fashion. Add Garden Green Satin Ribbon and finish with a bow pop into your box and use a glue dot to hold in place repeat for the other box and those two end boxes are complete
- 5. For the center box cut a piece of starry night paper from Be Merry DSP to measure 2" x 6" and score & create a backdrop as you did for the other two boxes
- 6. For the tea light holder cut a piece of Vellum to measure 2" x 4", texture with the Softly Falling Embossing Folder and score at 2" in fold along that score line- take a tea light and pop a glue dot on the side this will hold it to your vellum but you can still access the on/off switch on the bottom
- 7. Using a stamp from Merry Mistletoe & Garden Green ink, stamp a tree and cut it out add it to your vellum using a Dimensional and pop your tea light holder into the center box push it to the back so that you can see a little glittery snow on the floor at the front of that box
- 8. Line all three boxes up and use Tear & Tape Adhesive to hold them together
- 9. Take a strip of 11" long Whisper white cardstock and use the Decorative Ribbon Border to shape it add to the bottom edge using glue dots
- 10. Stamp another green tree and then the reindeer using Early Espresso Ink and cut them out using Paper Snips add to your box using Dimensionals

- 11. Use a die from Seasonal Layers Thinlits to cut out a snowflake and add to the box along with a silver jewel in the center from Metallic Enamel Shapes
- 12. To create the tag on the top, stamp 'Christmas Wishes' using Early Espresso Ink and cut out using an oval die from Stitched Shapes Framelits use hot glue to attach to a Box Wood Wreath
- 13. Punch a few small circles of Cherry Cobbler cardstock to make berries and tuck them onto the wreath between the leaves using glue dots
- 14. Add a bow made of White Bakers Twine and pop another Metallic Enamel jewel on top of it
- 15. Attach to the center box lid using Dimensionals be sure to only attach it to this one lid so that you can still open & close it to turn the tea light on and off...
