Wood Crate Cookie Treat



Supplies:

Stamps: Wood Words (CM 143928/CM 143925), Label Me Pretty (CM 143861/WM 143858) Bundles: Wood Crate (CM 145316/WM 145315), Label Me Pretty (CM 145305/WM 145304)

Dies: Wood Crate Framelits (143730), Big Shot (143263)

Punches: Pretty Label (143715)

Ribbon: Cherry Cobbler 1/4" Double Stitched (144117), Gold Mini Sequin Trim (144128), Very Vanilla Solid Bakers Twine (144224)

Cardstocks: Soft Suede (115318), Very Vanilla (101650)

Inks: Soft Suede (126978), Cherry Cobbler (126966)

Misc: Metallic Enamel Shapes (141678), 3x6 Cello Bags (141704), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Dimensionals (104430), Fast Fuse (129026)

Instructions:

- 1. Use the crate die from Wood Crate Framelits to cut two pieces from Soft Suede cardstock
- 2. Fold along all score lines and adhere the bottom panels to one another use Fast Fuse on the side tabs, fold up and adhere in place your crate is assembled
- 3. Stamp your label onto Very Vanilla cardstock using a stamp from Label Me Pretty and punch it out using the Pretty Label Punch add to the front of the crate using Dimensionals
- 4. Take two small gold hearts from Metallic Enamel Shapes and tuck them just under the end of the label at each side so that they are peeking out they are self adhesive so no glue required
- 5. Package your cookies into a cello bag and secure the top with a piece of Very Vanilla Solid Bakers Twine, finishing with a knot leave the long ends dangling at the front.
- 6. Stamp two hearts using a stamp from Wood Words 1 Soft Suede and 1 Cherry Cobbler and cut them out using the heart shaped die from Wood Crate Framelits use a Mini Glue Dot to attach each to an end of the vanilla twine but before that, trim the twine to the lengths you wish it to be I staggered mine for a cute look
- 7. Tie around a piece of Mini Gold Sequin Trim and leave those ends dangling at the front
- 8. Tie around a piece of Cherry Cobbler Double Stitched Ribbon and finish with a bow in the front
- 9. Pop your filled & completed cello bag into the wood crate and it is ready for gifting $\, \odot \,$
