## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Gourd Goodness Photopolymer Stamp Set [144785]
- Inks: Early Espresso Classic Stampin' Pad [126974]
- Cardstock: Crushed Curry 8-1/2" X II" Card Stock [13199], Early Espresso 8-1/2" X II" Card Stock [19686], Garden Green 8-1/2" X II" Card Stock [102584], Whisper White 8-1/2" X II" Card Stock [100730], Vellum 8-1/2" X II" Card Stock [101856]
- Designer Paper: Painted Autumn Designer Series Paper [144613]
- Tools: Layering Circle Framelits Dies [141705], Leaf Punch [144667], Simply Scored [122334], Classic Label Punch [141491], Banner Triple Punch [138292]
- Miscellaneous: Wooden Clips (Target Dollar bin), Petite Café Bags (Retired Stampin' Up!)

## INSTRUCTIONS:


l. First, add designer series paper to the front of Petite Café Bags.



2. Cut a 2" strip of vellum and l" strip of designer series paper and then punch the ends with the Banner Triple Punch to create flags. Adhere them both to the front of the bag.



3. Cut a strip of designer series paper  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" and  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 6". Using the Simply Scored tool score every  $\frac{1}{2}$ " along the long side of both strips.



4. Fold on the score lines and then hot glue the ends together creating a ring. Squish down to make a rosette and hot glue together to secure.

5. Stamp the sentiment and cut out the rest of the pieces to decorate the rosette.

6. Hot glue to the clip and then attached to your bag! Fill with sunflower seeds or candy and you have a pretty cute little gift!
