Pumpkin Spice Latte with a Copper Leaf Fall themed Card



Supplies:

Stamps: Merry Cafe (144965)

DSP & Specialty Paper: Coffee Break (144155), Spooky Night (144610), Copper Foil (142020) **Die Cutting**: Coffee Cups Framelits (143745), Leaflets Framelits (138283), Big Shot (143263)

Embossing Folder: Cable Knit Dynamic (143537)

Ribbon & Twine: 1/4" Copper Trim (144179), Copper Metallic Thread (141696), Linen Thread (104199)

Cardstocks: Very Vanilla Thick (144237), Soft Suede (115318), Very Vanilla (101650)

Ink: Soft Suede (126978)

Misc: Cookie Cutter Punch (140396), Corrugated Elements (144158), Metallics Sequins (144214), Dimensionals

(104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: Very Vanilla Thick 4 ¼" x 11" - scored at 5 ½"

Layer: Soft Suede 5 1/8" x 3 7/8"
Textured layer: Very Vanilla 5 x 3 ¾"

Instructions:

- 1. Cut the Soft Suede layer and adhere to the Very Vanilla Thick base
- 2. Cut the top Vanilla layer and emboss using the Cable Knit Dynamic Embossing Folder cut a strip of green & heart patterned paper from Coffee Break DSP to measure 3 ¾" x ¾" and adhere in place across the layer
- 3. Attach the embossed layer to the card base and wrap around a piece of Copper Trim, securing with tape on the back just below this wrap Linen Thread around twice and secure
- 4. Die cut a leaf from Copper Foil using a die from Leaflets Framelits and adhere in place
- 5. Tie a bow from Linen Thread and add to the leaf stem with half of a glue dot tie another bow using 4 strands of Copper Metallic Thread and pop on top
- 6. Die cut the cup shape, band and lid using a die from Coffee Cups Framelits the body of the cup is cut from paper found in Spooky Night DSP use stamps from Merry Café to decorate the die cuts and assemble
- 7. Use Dimensionals to add the cup to the card and a small kraft heart to the band − I punched mine out of a Corrugated Element using the Cookie Cutter Punch. Pop on a copper sequin and you are done ☺
