

## Painted Harvest meets Touches of Nature Card



### Supplies:

**Stamps:** Painted Harvest (144783)

**Bundle:** Painted Harvest Bundle (146021)

**Die Cutting & Punch:** Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Big Shot (143263), Leaf Punch (144667)

**Cardstocks:** Soft Suede (115318), Sahara Sand (121043), Cajun Craze (119684), Very Vanilla (101650)

**Inks:** Crushed Curry (131173), Cajun Craze (126965), Soft Suede (126978), Sahara Sand (126976)

**Marker:** Neutrals Stampin' Write Markers (131261)

**Misc:** Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush (141897), Touches of Nature Elements (144216), Linen Thread (104199), Paper Snips (103579), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

### Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Soft Suede 4 ¼" x 11" - scored at 5 ½"
- Layers: Sahara Sand 5 ¼" x 4", Cajun Craze 5 1/8" x 3 7/8", Very Vanilla 5" x 3 ¾"

### Instructions:

1. Cut the Cajun Craze and Sahara Sand layers and adhere to the Soft Suede card base
2. Cut the Very Vanilla layer and use the Sahara Sand Marker to flick ink onto it to create a splatter pattern
3. Stamp the leaves using Sahara Sand ink directly onto this splattered layer
4. Take a scrap of Very Vanilla cardstock and use stamps from Painted Harvest to make the watercolored flower – use Crushed Curry for the largest flower layer, Cajun Craze for the second and Soft Suede for the center – cut out using Paper Snips and add to the layer using a Mini Glue Dot in the center. Brush over this flower with your Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush. Stamp another partial flower in the bottom right corner
5. Wrap around Linen Thread and adhere to the card base
6. Use an oval die from Stitched Shapes Framelits to create the center panel and stamp the sentiment onto it using Soft Suede Ink – add to the card using Dimensionals
7. Stamp two more leaf pieces onto scrap cardstock – one using Sahara Sand and the other Soft Suede – and punch out using the Leaf Punch – add to your card
8. Take a wood flower and leaf from Touches of Nature Elements – use Crushed Curry Ink to color the flower, leave it to dry, pop on a Linen Thread bow and add to the stem. You can add the leaf as is, or is you prefer a thin leaf like I have on my card, peel off the top veneer and add next to the flower.
