

Patterned Pumpkins Die Cut Background Thank You Card



Supplies:

Stamp: One Big Meaning (CM 139420/WM 138788)

Dies: Patterned Pumpkins Thinlits (144670), Layering Ovals Framelits (141706), Big Shot (143263)

DSP: Spooky Night (144610)

Cardstocks: Very Vanilla Thick (144237), Very Vanilla (101650), Early Espresso (119686),

Ink: Early Espresso (126974)

Misc: Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309), Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Very Vanilla Thick 8 ½" x 5 ½" - scored at 4 ¼"
- Brown layer: Early Espresso 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"
- Vanilla layer: Very Vanilla 3 3/4" x 5"

Instructions:

1. Adhere the brown layer to the card base
2. Using a die from Patterned Pumpkins Thinlits die cut some leafy stems and position on the Very Vanilla layer – when happy with placement, adhere in place using the Fine Tip Glue Pen. Use your paper trimmer to trim the ends off the stems around the side – adhere this layer to your card base
3. Use the largest oval die in Layering Ovals Framelits to cut your shape from Very Vanilla and use a stamp from One Big Meaning to stamp 'Thank You' onto it using Early Espresso Ink
4. Take the sheet of paper covered in pumpkins from Spooky Night DSP and use two dies from Patterned Pumpkins Thinlits to die cut out the pumpkins you want to use – add the back one to the oval using adhesive and the second using Dimensionals to elevate it
5. Add the oval to card base using Dimensionals
6. Die cut an Early Espresso leafy stem and add it using Fine Tip Glue - and now your card is done and ready for giving 😊
