

Ghost Topper for Treat Tube Halloween Treats



Supplies:

Stamp: Pick a Pumpkin (CM 144993/WM 144989)

Dies: Patterned Pumpkins Thinlits (144670), Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Up & Away Thinlits (142748), Big Shot (143263)

BUNDLE: Pick a Pumpkin Bundle (CM 146025/WM 146024)

Punch: 1/8" Handheld Circle (134365)

Cardstocks: Daffodil Delight (119683), Basic Black (121045), Whisper White (100730)

DSP: Spooky Night (144610)

Trim & Twine: Whisper White Solid (124262), Basic Black Solid (141682), Mini Silver Sequin Trim (144230)

Misc: Treat Tubes (144612), Black Rhinestone Jewels (144639), Basic Black Archival Ink (140931), Paper Snips (103579), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

For both – use the smallest circle die in Stitched Shapes Framelits to cut the circle out of Daffodil Delight cardstock and use the 1/8" handheld Circle Punch to make a hole at the top - fill tubes with candies – and make the ghosts (instructions below)

The 'Spooked Jack-o-lantern' Topper

- Take the sheet of patterned paper covered in pumpkins out of your pack of Spooky Night DSP and use a die from Patterned Pumpkins Thinlits to cut out your jack-o-lantern
- Adhere your ghost to the yellow circle and using Dimensionals to pop the jack-o-lantern on top
- Take the sheet of paper that has words all over it from Spooky Night DSP and cut out the word 'boo' with Paper Snips – use glue to add to the circle.
- Thread the Black Bakers Twine through the hole and take it up and over the cork, securing on the back with tape and then tie on a bow just below the cork

The 'Ghost in Clouds' Topper

- Use dies from Up & Away Thinlits to cut two clouds from Basic Black cardstock. Adhere the larger one to the back of the yellow circle and the smaller one to the front
- Cut out 'boo' from that sheet of DSP and add using glue along with two Silver Mini Sequins
- Attach the Ghost using a Dimensional
- Thread the White Bakers Twine through the hole and take it up and over the cork, securing on the back with tape and then tie on a bow just below the cork

The Ghost

Take the gourd die from Patterned Pumpkins Thinlits and use it to cut out a white shape – then use sharp paper snips to round off the small end...



Take this stamp from the set Pick a Pumpkin...



If you want your ghost to have a sad face, you can skip the next few steps and simply stamp the face onto your ghost. If you want to have a smiley face, this is how you do it – cover the mouth with a piece of masking tape...



Ink up the stamp...



Remove the masking tape...



And stamp onto your ghost shape...



Clean your stamp and then pop masking tape over the eyes...



Ink up the stamp and remove the masking tape...



And turn the stamp upside down to stamp a smiley mouth on to your ghost...
