Spooky Cat meets Patterned Pumpkins on a Spooky Night Card



Supplies:

Stamp: Spooky Cat (144749) BUNDLE: Spooky Cat (146014)

Dies: Patterned Pumpkins Thinlits (144670), Bunch of Banners Framelits (141488)

DSP: Spooky Night (144610)

Punch: Cat (144666)

Cardstocks: Shimmery White (101910), Basic Black (121045), Cajun Craze (119684)

Ink: Basic Black Archival (140931)

Ribbon & Twine: Vintage Crochet Trim (144611), Black Mini Sequin Trim (144259)

Misc: Pattern Party Decorative Masks (144103), Embossing Paste (141979), Palette Knives (142808), Black Rhinestone Jewels (144639), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332), Masking Tape

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: Basic Black 4 ¼" x 11" - scored at 5 ½"

Layer: Cajun Craze 5 1/4" x 4"

Instructions:

- 1. Cut the Cajun Craze layer and add it to the Basic Black base
- 2. Cut a piece of DSP with the moon & trees to measure 3 7/8" wide x 1" and attach at the top of the Cajun layer
- 3. Cut a strip of Basic Black cardstock to measure 4" x ¼" and adhere ¾" down from the top of the patterned background to give you a black bar that goes across your card front
- 4. Wrap around a piece of Black Mini Sequin Trim 2" down from the top and secure at the back with tape
- 5. Cut a piece of Shimmery White cardstock to measure 4 7/8" wide x 4 3/8" use a brick patterned mask & position it on the cardstock use tape to hold in place & use masking tape to tape off areas you don't want paste –use a Palette Knife to apply the paste, remove & clean the mask and set the cardstock aside to dry

- 6. Use the Cat Punch to punch out a black cat and use pumpkin dies from Patterned Pumpkin Thinlits to cut out the pumpkins and jack-o-lantern both sheets of paper featuring these images are in Spooky Night DSP
- 7. When the Embossing Paste is dry, add those images I used tape for the back two pumpkins and Dimensionals for the cat and jack-o-lantern along with a couple of Black Rhinestone Jewels dotted around
- 8. Stamp Happy Halloween using a stamp from Spooky Cat and cut it out using a die from Bunch of Banners. Die cut two black swirls using a die from Patterned Pumpkins Thinlits and adhere into place
- 9. Attach this layer to your Cajun layer wrap around a piece of Vintage Crochet Trim along the black bar near the top of your card secure at the back of the card front using tape and there is your spooky card ☺
