

Alien Eyeball Treat

Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Seasonal Chums
- Inks: Archival Basic Black
- · Cardstock (CS): Tangerine Tango, Rich Razzleberry, Lemon Lime Twist, Whisper White, Basic Black
- Tools: Paper Trimmer, Big Shot, Layering Ovals Framelits, Home Sweet Home Thinlits Dies, Patterned Pumpkins Thinlits
 Dies, Softly Falling Emboss Folder, Classic Label Punch, 1/2" Circle Punch, White Stampin' Chalk Marker, Black
 Journaling Pen
- Miscellaneous: Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Dimensionals, Stapler, Reese's Eyeballs

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Start with a $2\,3/4$ " x 9" piece of Tangerine Tango CS. Score on the horizontal at $3\,3/4$ ", $4\,1/4$ ", & $8\,1/4$ ". Then using the 3rd Oval Framelit in the order from smallest to biggest cut an oval about 3/8" down from the top front as shown.



2. Next emboss the front and top and bottom edge using the Gently Falling Emboss Folder.



3. Cut a piece of Lemon Lime Twist CS 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" and attach it to the inside with Tombow Liquid Glue.



4. Fold up bottom flap and add a staple a little more than 1/16" from the bottom.



5. Using the Vine Thinlet from the Pattern Pumpkins Thinlets and the Banner Thinlet from the Home Sweet Home Thinlets cut out pieces as shown below. (There are also other pieces that would be just as cute for antennas also in the Pattern Pumpkins Set.)



- 6. Stamp the phrase "Trick or Treat" in Archival Black onto a scrap of Whisper White CS and punch out using the Classic Label Punch. Punch out a 1/2" Circle using a scrap of Basic Black CS.
- 7. Attach the antennas to the back of your base. Layer the phrase and a piece of Rich Razzleberry CS measuring 2 1/4" x 1/2" to the bottom flap being sure to cover the staple. Attach the teeth as shown under the eye opening. Use the White Chalk Marker to add a little gleam to the 1/2" black circle and attach it to the center of the eye. Use Dimensionals to attach the Reese's eyeball candy to inside base.





You can stop at this point and be done if you like but if you want the inside to be a bit cuter, keep going.

8. Cut a piece of Rich Razzleberry 2 1/2" x 3 1/4". Run it through the Big Shot using the same Oval Framelit as before, again about 3/8" down from top. Cut a 1 1/2" square of Lemon Lime Twist and cut into 2 triangles. Using a Black Journaling Pen write the phrase, "I've got my eye on you!" on one of the triangles as shown.



9. Attach the Rich Razzleberry piece over the Lemon Lime Twist base. Attach the triangle with phrase in the upper right hand corner. And you are done! I hope you have enjoyed this project as much as I've enjoyed making it.
