Brightly Lit Bicycle Holiday Card



Supplies:

Stamp: Brightly Lit Christmas (144807), At Home With You (143681), Bike Ride (143716) **BUNDLES**: Brightly Lit Christmas (146040), At Home With You (145351), Bike Ride (145314)

Die Cutting & Embossing: Christmas Lamppost Thinlits (144675), At Home Framelits (143727), Build a Bike (143729),

Softly Falling (139672), Big Shot (143263)

Cardstocks: Gold Glimmer (133719), Basic Black (121045), Whisper White (100730)

DSP: Merry Little Christmas (144621)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Old Olive Blends

Ribbon: Mini Gold Sequin Trim (144128), Mini Black Sequin Trim (144259), Gold Metallic Thread (138401) **Misc**: Gold Stampin' Glitter (133457), Black Rhinestone Jewels (144639), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309), Mini

Dimensionals (144108), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: Basic Black 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

• Layers: Merry Little Christmas DSP 4" x 5 1/4", Whisper White 3 3/4" x 5", Whisper White 3 5/8" x 4 7/8"

Instructions:

- 1. Cut the DSP layer and adhere to the Black base wrap around a piece of Black Shimmer Ribbon with a double piece of Gold Metallic Thread on top and secure in place
- 2. Take the smallest White layer and use the Softly Falling Embossing Folder to texture it and adhere to the larger White layer
- 3. Use dies from Christmas Lamppost Thinlits to cut the lamp pieces from Black cardstock and cut the lamp insert from Gold Glimmer Paper adhere in place.
- 4. Stamp the banner using a stamp from Brightly Lit Christmas and cut it and the hanger and adhere in place I used an Old Olive marker to color the word 'Time'
- 5. Use stamps and dies from the Bike Ride Bundle to create your bicycle and adhere in place
- 6. Use stamps and a die from the At Home With You Bundle to create the wreaths and use markers to color in
- 7. Use the Fine Tip Glue Pen to apply glue to the berries and sprinkle on Gold Glitter shake off and add to the card. I used Mini Dimensionals to add the wreath to the lamppost and glue dots for the ones on the wheels
- 8. Dot around some Mini Sequins, add a sprig of holly cut from another wreath to the banner and you are done!
