Starry Eyed Cat in the Window Card



Supplies:

Stamp: Thoughtful Banners (141614)
Cardstocks: Silver Foil (132178), Fresh Fig (144242), Basic Black (121045), Whisper White (100730)
DSP: Merry Little Christmas (144621), Year of Cheer Specialty (144640), Spooky Night (144610)
Embossing: Quilt Top (144687)
Die Cutting: Hearth & Home (139666), Popcorn Box Thinlits (141473), Big Shot (143263)
Punch: Cat (144666)
Ink: Basic Black Archival (140931)
Ribbon: Basic Black 3/8" Shimmer (144129), Silver 3/8" Metallic Edge (144213)
Misc: Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Basic Black 4 1/4" x 11" scored at 5 1/2"
- Layers: Whisper White 4" x 5 1/4", Merry Little Christmas DSP 3 7/8" x 5 1/8", Fresh Fig 3 3/8" x 4 5/8"

Instructions:

- 1. Cut the black plaid DSP and adhere to the White layer and then the Black card base
- 2. Cut the Fresh Fig mat and texture using the Quilt Top Embossing Folder and adhere in place
- 3. Wrap around a piece of Silver Metallic Edge Ribbon and then a piece of Black Shimmer Ribbon over it and tape in place
- 4. Die cut the window & sill from White cardstock and pop a piece of starry paper from Year of Cheer Specialty DSP behind the window stamp 'thank you' onto the sill and add to the card
- 5. Use the Cat Punch to punch out a cat from a sheet of Spooky Night DSP and attach to the window
- 6. Use the small star die from Popcorn Box Thinlits to cut two stars from Silver Foil Paper and adhere in place
- 7. And there you have one beautiful cat card perfect for a cat lover $\, \odot \,$
