

## STAMPIN' BLENDS STORAGE CASE

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## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Painters Palette
- Inks: Powder Pink, Rich Razzleberry
- Cardstock: Pink Pirouette
- Designer Paper: Pick A Pattern
- Accessories: Crushed Curry 3/8" Stitched Satin Ribbon
- Tools: Full Wide Stamp Cases, Paper Trimmer, Stampin' Blends Brochure from your Stampin' Up! Demonstrator

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

Case Insert Layers:

- Layer #1: Pick A Pattern Designer Paper 11" x 7". I chose the designer paper sheet with the artist tools in the design. Insert under the clear sleeve and snap the case closed. Run your fingers over the spine to crease the designer paper. Remove designer paper from case to finish adding layers to the front.
- Layer #2: Pick A Pattern Designer Paper 5-1/2" x 4-1/4". Glue to the right-hand side of the paper, centered between the edge of the designer paper and the folded crease.
- Layer #3: Using the front page of the brochure, cut straight across right below the Stampin' Up! Logo on the bottom as close as you can. Cut above the Stampin' Blends wording so that the length of the page is 5" long. For the width of the page, center the Stampin' Blends wording and the total measurement width should be 3-3/4" when cutting off on both sides. The page should now measure 5" x 3-3/4". Glue to the center of the designer paper layer.
- Layer #4: Cut a piece of Pink Pirouette Cardstock to measure 1" x 4-3/4". Cut both ends into a "V". Stamp the sentiment using Rich Razzleberry Ink in the center. Stamp using Powder Pink Ink, the swoosh image repeatedly around the sentiment. Glue to front of insert just below the words Stampin' Blends.
- Slide completed insert under the clear sleeve.
- Ribbon: Wrap the ribbon around the case and tie into a bow. The ribbon should be able to slide off and on to open the case. The ribbon helps keep the case closed during travel!
- Fill with Stampin' Blends!
