



Holiday Clear Envelope Mini Scrapbook Album

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used on the album featured above:

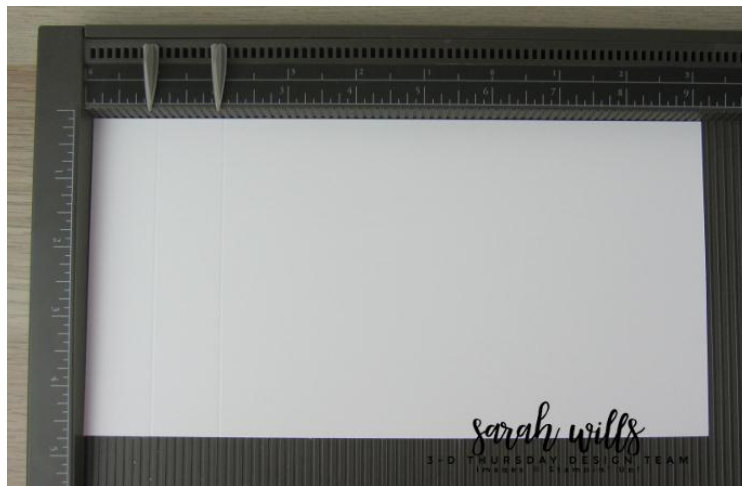
- **Stamp:** Back in Plaid (2017 November Paper Pumpkin)
- **Cardstocks:** Crumb Cake (120953), Whisper White (100730), Lemon Lime Twist (144245)
- **DSP:** Christmas Around the World (144629)
- **Die Cutting & Embossing:** Many Mittens Framelits (144672), Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Polka Dot Basics (143709), White Wonder (144686), Big Shot (143263)
- **Tools:** Simply Scored (122334)
- **Ink:** Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)
- **Ribbon:** Silver 3/8" Metallic Edge (144213)
- **Misc:** Clear Medium Envelopes (102619), Foil Snowflakes (144642), Rhinestone Jewels (144220), Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332), Tear & Tape (138995)
- **Optional:** 1/8" Circle Punch (134365)

INSTRUCTIONS:

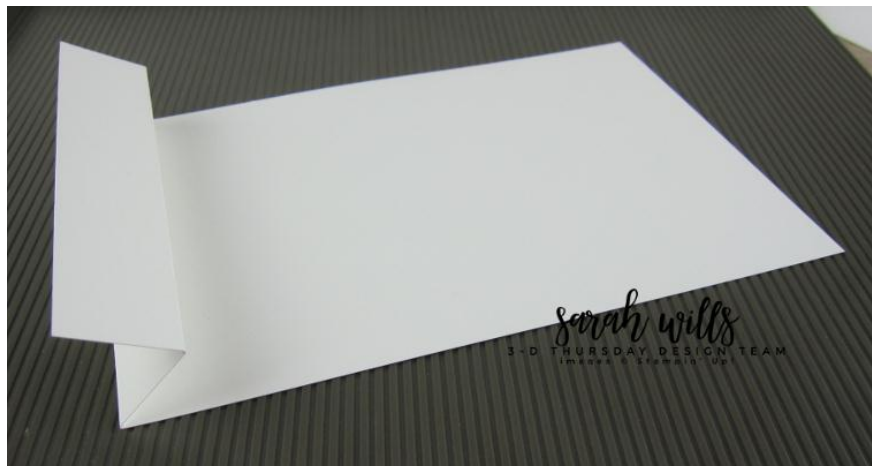
1 – Cut two pieces of cardstock to measure: $4 \frac{3}{4}'' \times 9 \frac{1}{4}''$ and $4 \frac{3}{4}'' \times 6 \frac{1}{4}''$



2 – Place the larger piece in your score tool with the longest side along the top and score at 1" & 2"



3 – And fold along those score lines like so...



4 – Apply strong adhesive tape such as Tear & Tape to the top surface of the end flap...



5 – And adhere the second piece of cardstock to it – and that is your basic mini scrapbook cover – easy!



6 – Now to decorate! As a guideline, to cover the spine section cut a piece of patterned paper to be 1" x 4 3/4" – you might want to trim it narrower so that your cover can fold back for easy viewing inside – play with positioning it before adhering in place. For the front cover cut a piece to be 6" x 4 1/2" and adhere in place...



7 – You can also put patterned paper inside too if you wish to do so – cut one piece to be 6" x 4 1/2" for the front and the second to be 7" x 4 1/2" for the back and adhere in place



8 – To make the insert covers take some Clear Envelopes (you can use as many as you like but I used 6 in this one) – they will hold your photos or cards inside the album...



9 – Take the first envelope and tear off the backing for the adhesive tape on the flap, line it up and push down to secure in place on the inside back cover...



10 – Do the same thing with the remaining clear envelopes so that they are stacked on top of one another...



11 – To cover up the adhesive strips of the envelopes you can either apply strong adhesive tape to that spine area as I did with my album in the main photo of this project sheet and adhere the spine section of the front cover to it OR you can use ribbon to do it. To use ribbon – punch two holes through all layers using a handheld circle punch or other hole making tool...



12 – And thread through your ribbon and finish with a knot or bow...



13 – When you open it up you can slide your photos or cards in each clear envelope using the opening on the back – you can fit items up to 4 1/4" x 5 7/8" in each...



14 – Fill all envelopes and finish decorating the front...
