

# Holiday Clear Envelope Mini Scrapbook Album

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


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### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used on the album featured above:

- Stamp: Back in Plaid (2017 November Paper Pumpkin)
- Cardstocks: Crumb Cake (120953), Whisper White (100730), Lemon Lime Twist (144245)
- **DSP**: Christmas Around the World (144629)
- **Die Cutting & Embossing**: Many Mittens Framelits (144672), Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Polka Dot Basics (143709), White Wonder (144686), Big Shot (143263)
- Tools: Simply Scored (122334)
- Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)
- Ribbon: Silver 3/8" Metallic Edge (144213)
- **Misc**: Clear Medium Envelopes (102619), Foil Snowflakes (144642), Rhinestone Jewels (144220), Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332), Tear & Tape (138995)
- **Optional**: 1/8" Circle Punch (134365)


# **INSTRUCTIONS:** 1 – Cut two pieces of cardstock to measure: $43/4" \times 91/4"$ and $43/4" \times 61/4"$ sorah wills 2 – Place the larger piece in your score tool with the longest side along the top and score at 1" & 2" sorgh wills 3 – And fold along those score lines like so...







10 – Do the same thing with the remaining clear envelopes so that they are stacked on top of one another...



11 – To cover up the adhesive strips of the envelopes you can either apply strong adhesive tape to that spine area as I did with my album in the main photo of this project sheet and adhere the spine section of the front cover to it OR you can use ribbon to do it. To use ribbon – punch two holes through all layers using a handheld circle punch or other hole making tool...



12 – And thread through your ribbon and finish with a knot or bow...



13 – When you open it up you can slide your photos or cards in each clear envelope using the opening on the back – you can fit items up to  $4 \frac{1}{4} \times 5 \frac{7}{8}$  in each...



14 – Fill all envelopes and finish decorating the front...
