

New Year's Row of Glasses Card



Supplies:

Stamps: Cheers to the Year (CM 144928/WM 144925), Mixed Drinks (141928)

Cardstocks: Whisper White (100730), Basic Black (121045)

Embossing: Oh My Stars (143710), Big Shot (143263)

Punches: 1 3/8" Circle (119860), 1/8" Circle Punch (134365)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Wink of Stella Glitter Brush (141897)

Blends Markers: Light Daffodil Delight (144586)

Ribbon & Trim: Basic Black Bakers Twine (141682), Vintage Crochet Trim (144611), Gold Mini Sequin Trim (144128), Gold Metallic Thread (138401)

Misc: Pick a Pattern Washi Tape (144166), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Whisper White 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"
- Layers: Basic Black 4" x 5 1/4", Whisper White 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"
- Strip: Whisper White 2 3/4" x 5 1/8"

Instructions:

1. Use a stamp from Mixed Drinks to stamp your row of champagne flutes – use a yellow Blends Marker to add color to one of them and go over it with your Wink of Stella Glitter Brush to add some sparkle
2. Use the Oh My Stars embossing folder to texture the White layer – add the stamped strip on top – then adhere to the Black layer
3. Wrap a piece of Vintage Crochet Trim around the bottom of the strip and add a piece of black scalloped Washi Tape at the top – add this layer to the card base
4. Wrap around a piece of Black Bakers Twine just above the Washi Tape and secure at the back of the card front with tape.
5. Wrap a double piece of Gold Metallic Thread around the glass stems and secure with tape at the back
6. Stamp the sentiment tag, shape using the 1 3/8" Circle Punch, and punch a small hole to thread bakers twine through
7. Add the tag to the card using a Dimensional and use bakers twine to tie it on to the line of Black thread above finishing with a bow
