

Picnic Basket Candy Holder



Supplies:

Stamps: Picnic with You (145860)

Die Cutting & Embossing: Picnic Basket Builder Framelits (145658), Apron Builder Framelits (145661), Basket Weave Dynamic EF (146841), Big Shot (143263)

BUNDLE: Picnic with You Bundle (145980)

Punches: 1 ½" Circle (138299), 1/16" Circle (134363)

Cardstock: Whisper White (100730), Cherry Cobbler (119685), Old Olive (100702)

Ink: Soft Suede (126978), Cherry Cobbler (126966)

Ribbon & Twine: Old Olive 1/8" Sheer Ribbon (144171), Whisper White Solid Bakers Twine (124262)

Misc: 2" x 8" Cellophane Tube Bags (141703), M&Ms, Tear & Tape (138995), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

Instructions:

1. Stamp two baskets and use the coordinating die to cut them out – take a piece of Tear & Tape Adhesive and cut in half length ways so you have two thin strips – apply a strip to each side of the inside of one of the baskets – add the other side to it and push firmly together
2. Stamp the red cloth and adhere in place
3. Fill a food safe Cello Tube bag with candies and use a piece of ribbon to tie around and secure the top
4. Take the basket and use your fingers to gently squeeze and open it up – push the cello tube inside
5. Die cut a green leaf stem and adhere to the bag
6. Stamp the tag, shape with a Circle Punch and tie onto the bag top with twine – and there you have one cute yummy candy filled treat ready for giving ☺
