

Picnic Basket Nugget Treat Box



Supplies:

Stamps: Picnic with You (145860)

Die Cutting & Embossing: Picnic Basket Builder Framelits (145658), Layering Ovals Framelits (141706), Basket Weave Dynamic EF (146841), Big Shot (143263)

BUNDLE: Picnic with You Bundle (145980)

Cardstocks: Whisper White (100730), Soft Suede (115318)

DSP: Bubbles & Fizz (147244)

Ink: Soft Suede (126978), Calypso Coral (126983), Lemon Lime Twist (144086)

Ribbon & Twine: Lemon Lime Twist 3/8" Mini Striped (145611), Whisper White Solid Bakers Twine (124262)

Misc: Simply Scored (122334), Tear & Tape (138995), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Instructions:

1. Cut two pieces of Soft Suede cardstock – one at 5" x 4" and the other at 4 7/8" x 3 7/8"
2. Texture both pieces with the Basket Weave Embossing Folder
3. Place the first piece into your score tool and make a score line 1" in from the edge – turn around and repeat on each of the other 3 sides – then do the same for the second piece of cardstock – fold along all score lines
4. Cut four slits on each piece to create flaps as shown below – and if you wish, on the larger piece use a circle punch to cut notches each side (this makes it easier to take the lid off but is not essential)



5. Turn both pieces over and apply very strong adhesive tape to the four small flaps – adhere each flap in place inside and this is what you will have...



6. And now it's time to fill and decorate!
7. Take some Hersheys Nuggets and cut strips of patterned papers to measure 1" x 3" – use strong adhesive tape to attach each strip to a Nugget...



8. When done, fill your box and pop the lid on...



9. I created a belly band with a piece of patterned paper – cut a strip and wrap it around your box – use your fingers to gently press on the corners to mark then score with your score tool to get a nice crisp fold. Be sure to keep your belly band a little loose so that it can slide off
10. Use stamps & die cuts to decorate the top – be sure to adhere your sentiment panel with decorations only to the belly band and not to the box itself...
11. And there you have one pretty box that you can theme for any occasion simply by using different papers, stamps and ribbons 😊
