## Ornamental Elegance Kit INSTRUCTIONS





**Step 1:** Assemble the Old Olive piece.



**A.** Fold the scored piece along the score lines.





**B.** Glue the scored piece to the flat piece at the center and along the folds (use just a small amount of glue on the creases). Press firmly in place.

**C.** Cut five pieces of tulle into 5" long pieces (as shown) and fold each into a wedge.

**D.** Glue the tip of a wedge to a scored ornament point. Repeat for all wedges.

**E.** Spread and tuck the tulle between the ornament points.

**Step 2:** Assemble the Real Red piece.



**A.** Fold the scored piece along the score lines.




**C.** Cut five pieces of thread into 8" pieces. Fold each piece in half, then in half again to make two loops.





**B.** Glue the scored piece to the flat piece at the center and along the folds (use just a small amount of glue on the creases). Press firmly in place.







**Step 3:** Assemble the rosette.





**A.** Accordion-fold the patterned strip and glue the ends together to create a circle. (The Old Olive pattern should be on the outside.)





C. Glue the circle piece to the center of the rosette with a strong adhesive, on the Old Olive side. Hold in place until the glue is dry.



**B.** Squeeze the circle together so it forms a cylinder, with the flat edges on top, then gently push down until it flattens into a rosette.



**D.** Glue the button to the Old Olive/Real Red side.

Step 4: Assemble all pieces. Make sure elements align correctly before gluing.



**A.** Glue the center of the Real Red piece to the Old Olive piece.



**B.** Glue the rosette to the center of the Real Red piece.



**C.** Adhere a pearl to the button.



**E.** Adjust ornament layers to create greater dimension.



**D.** Loop an 8" piece of thread and glue it to the back of the ornament.
