

Candy Corn Sour Cream Container



Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Spooky Fun (142236), Cookie Cutter Halloween (CM 142255/WM 142252)
- **Ink:** Tuxedo Black Memento (132708)
- **Cardstock:** Whisper White (100730)
- **DSP:** Brights DSP Stack (138434)
- **Die:** Tags & Labels Framelits (138282), Big Shot (143263)
- **Punch:** 1/8" Circle (134365)
- **Twine:** Black Bakers (141682)
- **Adhesive:** Fast Fuse (129326)

Cutting Measurements:

- Container base: Whisper 5 ½" x 4 ¼"
- Patterned paper strips: 5 ½" x 1 ½"

Instructions:

1. Cut your Whisper White and Patterned Paper Strips to size
2. Shape your white cardstock by rolling it – wrapping it around a thin can or jar helps to avoid creases – then apply a strip of very strong adhesive tape to one of the long sides - bring the other side over and be sure to press firmly to adhere
3. Apply strong adhesive tape to the reverse of the strip of yellow DSP and wrap around one end of the tube
4. Repeat for the strip of orange DSP – press both firmly in place
5. Take one end of the tube and use your fingers to firmly press the two edges together – use very strong adhesive tape to secure in place – you can also crimp the edge to help seal it/decoration
6. Take the container into your hands and turn 90 degrees – press the other two edges firmly together
7. Fill your container with candies
8. Use strong adhesive tape to seal the end and press firmly to secure – crimp if you would like
9. Stamp & shape your tag & tie on with Bakers Twine and you are done – a cute treat ready to go!
