

Thanksgiving/Fall Tic Tac Holder

Here is a very easy little treat that is perfect for Thanksgiving – it's a little Tic Tac Holder...pull on that ribbon and out pops a box of Tic Tacs!



Here's how to make it...if you want to know what supplies I used to decorate mine, you can find my blog post detailing it www.SarahsInkSpot.com – use the search box at the top to search for Tic Tac Holder

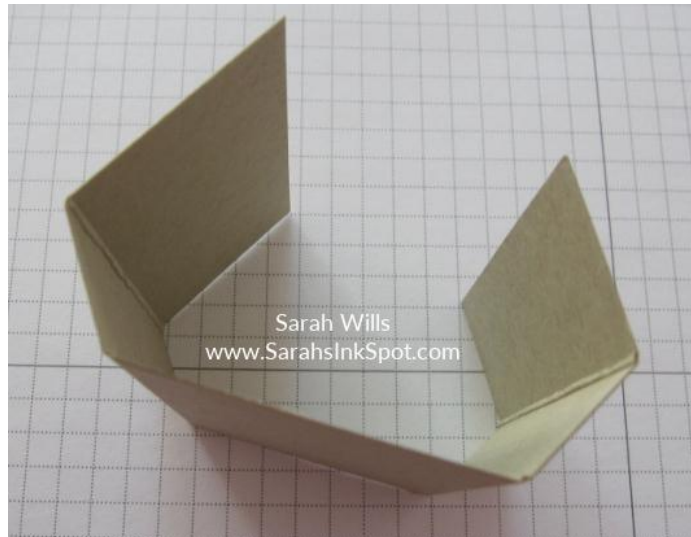
Cut a piece of cardstock to measure 5 3/4" x 3" - next you are going to score it - use your Paper Trimmer with Score Blade or Score Tool...



Score at 1", 1 3/4", 3 1/2" and 4 1/4"...



Then fold along the score lines...



Along one of the end edges run a line of very strong adhesive tape...



And adhere to the other end...



And that's your wrapper part done & ready to decorate!

Next for the slide out bit - take your box of Tic Tacs and a length of ribbon...



Wrap the ribbon around the box and use scotch tape to attach it front and back to hold it in place...



Trim the top ends, tie a piece of ribbon or twine around the top, slide it into your wrapper and you are ready to decorate!

You can literally theme it for any occasion – this one has a Fall/Thanksgiving theme going on but let your imagination and supplies run away with you!
