## Monster with a Chocolate Heart Card



## Supplies:

Stamps: Yummy in my Tummy (CM 143623/WM 142922)
Dies: Layering Circle Framelits (141705), Sweet & Sassy Framelits (141707), Big Shot (143263)
Punch: 1 1/4" Circle (119861)
Cardstocks: Tip Top Taupe (138336), Melon Mambo (115320), Chocolate Chip (102128), Very Vanilla (101650
Inks: Chocolate Chip (126979), Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)
Misc: Ghiradelli Heart Square

## **Cutting Measurements:**

- Card base: Melon Mambo 4 ¼" x 11" scored in center at 5 ½"
- Layer: Tip Top Taupe 4 ¼" x 3 ¾"
- Inside layer: Very Vanilla 3 ½" x 3 ½"

## Instructions:

- 1. Take the pink card base & cut ¼" off of one end flip and cut 1 ½" off the other end fold along the score line
- 2. Stamp the monster onto Tip Top Taupe use a die from Layering Circle Framelits to cut the circle window
- 3. Take the Ghiradelli Heart Square out of its packaging and pop into a food safe cello bag cut to size and seal
- 4. Position the cello filled bag behind the circle window and adhere in place then adhere to the small flap
- 5. Use a heart shaped die from Sweet & Sassy Framelits and cut three brown hearts attach to side
- 6. Stamp the sentiment and punch out using the Circle Punch attach to the flap using Dimensionals
- 7. Open the card and attach the Vanilla layer and then stamp a sentiment if desired or leave blank
- 8. And there you have one super cute Valentine's card with a chocolate treat  $\, \odot \,$
