

Sparkly Unicorn Gift Card Holding Card



Supplies:

Stamp: Jar of Love (141587)

Glitter Paper: 6" x 6" Glimmer Paper Assortment (143831)

Dies: Layering Squares Framelits (141708), Stars Framelits (133723), Up & Away Thinlits (142748), Big Shot (143263)

Punches: Confetti Stars (135861), Tree Builder (138295)

Cardstocks: Basic Black (121045), Rich Razzleberry (115316), Whisper White (100730)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

Misc: Basic Black Solid Bakers Twine (141682), Sprinkles Embellishments (142741), Rhinestone Jewels (119246), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Dimensionals (104430), Unicorn Gift Card (Target)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Basic Black 5 ½" x 8 ½" - scored in center at 4 ¼"
- Layer: Rich Razzleberry 3 ¾" x 5"
- Glittery layer: Sweet Sugarplum Glimmer 3 ½" x 4 ¾"

Instructions:

1. Take the glittered cardstock and use a square die from Layering Squares Framelits to cut a window
2. Pop the glittered layer onto the Razzleberry layer and use a pencil to draw the window shape onto the Razzleberry layer – then die cut a window out of that layer using your pencil marks as a guide to die placement
3. Repeat for the black card base – be sure to cut your window out of the front side ☺
4. Wrap black twine around your glittered layer in 2 places
5. Cut your black window frame by using two dies from Layering Squares Framelits – attach over your window hole to the glittered layer using Mini Glue Dots (I cut them in half)
6. Use Dimensionals to attach your glittered layer to the Razzleberry layer – and use Snail adhesive to attach them to your card base – be sure to line up over the windows ☺
7. Then decorate as desired – I cut a large star using a die from Stars Framelits and small stars using the Confetti Stars Punch and added them with Mini Glue Dots
8. The two little flowers were punched using the Tree Builder Punch and I popped a little Rhinestone onto each
9. Add a sentiment – I used the stamp 'for you' from Jar of Love and die cut the shape around it using a die from Up & Away Framelits and added it to my card using Dimensionals
10. Tape your Gift Card to the inside of your card front, being sure to line the character up with the window
