

Bunny in a Basket Card



Supplies:

Stamps: Basket Bunch (143186)

Dies: Basket Builder Framelits (143228), Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372)

Bundle: Basket Bunch Photopolymer Bundle (144731)

Cardstocks: Whisper White (100730), Soft Suede (115318), Cucumber Crush (138335), Sweet Sugarplum (141418), Pink Pirouette (111351)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

Markers: 2016-18 In Color (141393), Subtles (131263)

DSP: Succulent Garden DSP (142778)

Misc: White Bakers Twine (124262), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Dimensionals (104430), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Whisper White 4 ¼" x 11" - scored at 5 ½"
- White layer: Whisper White 5 1/8" x 3 7/8"
- DSP layer: Pink Gingham 3 ½" x 3 ½"

Instructions:

1. Using dies from Basket Builder Framelits, die cut the basket pieces & handle from Soft Suede, eggs from Pink Pirouette & Sweet Sugarplum and grass from Cucumber Crush
2. Stamp two bunnies and die cut them out – color the ears & bow ties with Markers – I used Pink Pirouette for the ears & Sweet Sugarplum for the bow ties
3. Use the largest square die from Stitched Shapes Framelits to cut the white square and then adhere it to the Gingham DSP, and then to the white layer - stamp your sentiment
4. Adhere the grass, basket & eggs in place – *be sure to only adhere the top basket around the edges so that you can tuck the die cuts inside for an authentic look* – tuck the bunny in on an angle and secure with a glue dot
5. Wrap a piece of White Bakers Twine around this layer – you can make & position your bow as I did or tie a bow on afterwards – add this layer to your card base using Dimensionals
6. Cut the other bunny to size and add to the bottom of the card – and there you have one cute Easter card ready to brighten someone's day 😊
