



DAISY DELIGHT DESKTOP POST-IT NOTE HOLDER

Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Delightful Daisy, Flourishing Phrases
- Inks: Calypso Coral, Old Olive, So Saffron
- Cardstock: Whisper White, Blushing Bride, Calypso Coral, Old Olive, So Saffron
- Designer Paper: Delightful Daisy
- Accessories: Old Olive Mini Chevron Ribbon
- Tools: Clear Wink Of Stella, Stampin' Dimensionals, Daisy Punch, Pretty Label Punch, Glue Dots, ½" Circle Punch
- Miscellaneous: 3" x 3" Post-It Note, 5" x 7" Plastic Frame (WalMart)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. You will need to cut the following layers:

- Whisper White Cardstock 5" x 7"
- Delightful Daisy Designer Paper 5" x 5" (old olive)
- Delightful Daisy Designer Paper 2" x 5" (calypso coral)



2. Glue the 2 layers of designer paper to the white cardstock piece. You will also need the following layers:

- Calypso Coral Cardstock 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Old Olive Cardstock 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"

Glue both cardstock layers together. Glue to the designer paper as shown (without the Post-It note):



3. Slide the designer paper layers inside the plastic frame. No need to glue as the ribbon will hold this in place. Wrap the ribbon around the frame where the two designer paper layers meet and tie into a bow. Use Glue Dots in a few places to glue the ribbon in place to the plastic frame. Glue the Post-It note onto the frame over the Old Olive layer, centered.



4. Stamp 4 daisies using Calypso Coral Ink on Blushing Bride Cardstock. Cut out using the Daisy Punch. Layer 2 flowers together as shown with all 4 flowers:



5. Stamp the sentiment on Whisper White Cardstock using Calypso Coral Ink. Cut out with the Pretty Label Punch and glue to the plastic frame using Stampin' Dimensionals. Glue the 2 flowers in place using Stampin' Dimensionals. Stamp 3 flower centers using So Saffron Ink and So Saffron Cardstock. Cut out using the 1/2" Circle Punch. Color all 3 stamped circles with Clear Wink Of Stella and glue 2 of the centers to each flower using Stampin' Dimensionals. Stamp 4 leaves with the lined leaf image and the bold leaf image with Old Olive Ink. I stamped the bold image on scrap paper first and stamped inside the lined image without re-inking. Hand-cut and glue to the frame, tucked under the flowers as shown with Glue Dots:



6. Stamp one flower in the center of the Post-It note using Calypso Coral Ink and glue the 3rd center using Stampin' Dimensionals:
