## **Merry Mistletoe Masculine Deer Birthday Card**



## **Supplies:**

Stamps: Merry Mistletoe (CM 143655/WM 143650), Tabs for Everything (143907)

Cardstocks: Soft Suede (115318), Crumb Cake (120953), Pear Pizzazz (131201), Whisper White (100730)

DSP & Glitter Paper: Coffee Break (144155), Gold Glimmer (133719)

**Inks:** Soft Suede (126978)

Dies: Leaflets Framelits (138283), Welcome Home Framelits (143752), Stitched Shapes (145372), Big Shot (143263)

Punch: 1" Circle (119868)

Ribbon & Trim: Gold Mini Sequin Trim (144128), Linen Thread (104199),

Misc: Corrugated Elements (144158), Paper Snips (103579), DImensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

Fine Tip Glue Pen(138309)

## **Cutting Measurements:**

Card base: Soft Suede 4 ¼" x 11" - scored at 5 ½"

Brown layer: Crumb Cake 4" x 5 ¼"
DSP layer: Coffee Break 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

## **Instructions**:

- 1. Use Snail adhesive to adhere the Crumb Cake layer to the card base add the patterned wood effect paper from Coffee Break DSP on top of that
- 2. Die cut two large leaves using dies from Leaflets Framelits and position where you want them to be use Snail to secure them in place
- 3. Stamp the deer using Soft Suede Ink and die cut using the largest Oval Die from Stitched Shapes Framelits use Dimensionals to add on top of the leaves
- 4. Use a die from Welcome Home Framelits to die cut glittered gold stems another small leaf die from Leaflets Framelits to cut a Crumb Cake leaf and position them where you want them to be secure the gold stems with Fine Tip Glue and the Crumb Cake leaf with Dimensionals add a Linen Thread bow and another gold stem die to the top of that leaf
- 5. Use stamps from Tabs for Everything to stamp the sentiment & punch out with the 1" Circle Punch add with Dimensionals
- 6. Take a mini gold sequin and add to the top of the card next to the leaf stems using a blob of Fine Tip Glue and pop a corrugated heart right at the bottom under the sentiment and there you have one cool masculine Birthday card ©
