

Merry Mistletoe Love Heart Christmas Card



Supplies:

Stamps: Merry Mistletoe (CM 143655/WM 143650)

Cardstocks: Early Espresso (119686), Whisper White (100730)

Glitter Paper: Dazzling Diamonds (135315)

DSP: Coffee Break (144155)

Inks: Early Espresso (126974), Real Red (126949), Garden Green (126973)

Dies: Seasonal Layers Thinlits (143751), Big Shot (143263)

Punch: Cookie Cutter Builder (140396)

Twine: Whisper White Solid Bakers Twine (124262)

Misc: Rhinestone Basic Jewels (144220), Paper Snips (103579), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332), Fine Tip Glue Pen(138309)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Early Espresso 8 ½" x 5 ½" - scored at 4 ¼"
- Green layer: Coffee Break DSP 3 5/8" x 5 ¼"
- Glitter layer: Dazzling Diamonds 3 ¾" x 4"
- White layer: Whisper White 3 ½" x 3 ¾"

Instructions:

1. Use Snail adhesive to adhere the green DSP layer to the card base
2. Stamp the Reindeer onto white cardstock using Early Espresso Ink – punch a small heart from Dazzling Diamonds Glitter Paper and add with a Mini Glue Dot
3. Add this to the glittered layer using Mini Glue Dots and then adhere to the card base
4. Die cut the branch from Early Espresso cardstock using a die from Seasonal Layers Thinlits and use the Fine Tip Glue Pen to add glue and attach to your card, being sure to overlap the layers on the right – use a paper trimmer or snips to trim off the excess branch
5. Stamp the mistletoe with Garden Green Ink and fussy cut out using Paper Snips. Add to the branch using Dimensionals and add a small white Bakers Twine bow
6. Stamp the Merry Christmas with Real Red Ink and fussy cut out – add to the card using Dimensionals
7. Die cut a snowflake from Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer Paper with a die from Seasonal Layers Thinlits and trim to size – attach in place with a Mini Glue Dot and add a sparkly Rhinestone in the center
