Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- **Stamps:** Coffee Café Photopolymer Stamp Set (143677), Coffee Café Photopolymer Bundle (145331)
- **Inks:** Soft Suede Classic Stampin' Pad (126978), Early Espresso Classic Stampin' Pad (126974), Garden Green Classic Stampin' Pad (126973), Old Olive Classic Stampin' Pad (126953)
- **Cardstock:** Whisper White 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock (100730), Garden Green 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock (102584), Basic Black 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock (121045), Early Espresso 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock (119686), Crumb Cake 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock (120953), Soft Sky 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock (131203)

INSTRUCTIONS for Coffee Cafe Note/Gift Card Holder:

1. Cut out a treat bag using the Mini Treat Bag Thinlits Dies, Wood Textures DSP and Big Shot.



2. Using the Coffee Café Stamp Set stamp the coffee cup with Soft Suede ink and the “Thanks A Latte” greeting with Garden Green ink on Whisper White Cardstock.

3. Using the Coffee Cups Framelits Dies cut out the shapes as well as the lid with Basic Black Cardstock, the spill stopper with Garden Green Cardstock and coffee cup sleeve with Crumb Cake Cardstock.

4. Adhere a piece of 2” x 3 3/4” Coffee Break DSP to the front of the treat bag. Wrap Old Olive 3/8” Mini Chevron Ribbon around the bag and tie a bow.

5. Assemble and adhere the coffee cup to the front of the bag using Dimensionals and mini glue dots.

6. For the note inside the treat bag cut a piece of Soft Sky Cardstock 3 1/2” x 5 1/4” and Whisper White Cardstock layer 3 1/4” x 5”. Stamp the “Happiness is a cup of Coffee shared with a Friend” in Soft Suede ink and coffee beans in Early Espresso ink. Add a piece of 1/2” x 3 1/2” Coffee Break DSP to the bottom.



7. Add a wooden spoon and Starbucks gift card and you're all set!



INSTRUCTIONS for Coffee Cafe K-cup Treat:

1. Unwrap a 4 oz. Espresso Cups to make a pattern. Using the pattern as a guide, trace the cup on a piece of Coffee Break DSP with a pencil and then cut out with Paper Snips. Adhere the Coffee Break DSP to a new cup using Tear & Tape Adhesive and then add Burlap Ribbon around the cup to make the coffee cup sleeve.



2. Hand cut a coffee pot and coffee cup out of Coffee Break DSP and add to a Whisper White circle punched with a 1-1/2" Circle Punch and then layered on a piece of Wood Textures DSP cut with a small scalloped circle from the Layering Circle Framelits Dies. Adhere to the front of the cup with Dimensionals.



3. Using the Coffee Café Stamp Set stamp the "Thanks A Latte" greeting with Old Olive ink on Whisper White Cardstock. Cut out with Coffee Cups Framelits Dies, layer on an oval from the Corrugated Elements, layer on a Garden Green circle punched with a 1-3/8" Circle Punch, layer on an Early Espresso circle punched with a 1-1/2" Circle Punch and then add to the top of the cup.



4. Add a k-cup of your choice, chocolate and Starbucks Spill Stopper. ENJOY!
