Watercolor Wash Beach Adirondack Card



Supplies:

Stamps: Colorful Seasons (143726), Eastern Beauty (143675)

Dies: Seasonal Layers Thinlits (143751), Welcome Home Framelits (143752), Big Shot (143263)

BUNDLE: Colorful Seasons Photopolymer Bundle (145348)

Inks: Dapper Denim Refill (141399). Crumb Cake (126975), Soft Sky (131181)

Cardstocks: Watercolor (122959), Crumb Cake (120953), Lemon Lime Twist (144245), Whisper White (100730)

Ribbon & Twine: Linen Thread (104199), Gold Mini Seguin Trim (144128)

Misc: Aqua Painters (103954), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309), Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: Crumb Cake 4 ¼" x 11" - scored at 5 ½"

• White layer: Whisper White 5" x 3 34"

• White layer: Watercolor paper 4 7/8" x 3 5/8"

Instructions:

- 1. Pop a drop of Dapper Denim Refill onto a disposable plate and use an Aqua Painter to apply to the Watercolor Paper use wide sweeping motions to create a nice watercolor wash look and as necessary, reload the brush with fresh color and continue downwards until you are happy with the look allow to dry
- 2. Add a piece of Linen Thread and secure on the back adhere this layer to the Crumb Cake base
- 3. Die cut the chair from White cardstock and use a Fine Tip Glue Pen to attach to the watercolor background
- 4. Stamp the 'hello' sentiment using a stamp from Eastern Beauty and Crumb Cake Ink directly onto the card, just under Linen Thread
- 5. Stamp the flower using a stamp from Colorful Seasons and Soft Sky Ink and die cut using the coordinating die from Seasonal Layers Thinlits
- 6. Die cut two stems from Lemon Lime Twist cardstock using a die from Welcome Home Framelits adhere to the card using Fine Tip Glue add a Linen Thread bow to the left of them
- 7. Add the flower using a Dimensional and then two Mini Gold Sequins for a little summer bling and there you have one beautiful summer themed card ready for giving ©
