Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Cookie Cutter (142043), Ready for Christmas (144823)

Dies: Wood Crate Framelits (143730), Santas Sleigh Thinlits (140278), Popcorn Box Thinlits

(141473), Seasonal Layers Thinlits (143751), Big Shot (143263)

Punch: Cookie Cutter Builder (140396)

Cardstocks: Early Espresso (119686), Crumb Cake (120953), Garden Green (102584), Marina Mist (119682), Whisper White (100730), Thick Whisper White (140272), Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer (125215), Silver Feil (122178)

Ink: Early Espresso (126974)

Markers: Neutrals (131261), Subtles (131263)

Ribbons: Whisper White 3/8" Classic Weave (144159), Silver Mini Sequin Trim (144230), Silver Metallic Thread (138402), Silver 1/8" Ribbon (132137), Tinsel Trim (144636)

Misc: Dazzling Diamonds Glitter (133751), Boxwood Wreaths (144176), Metallic Enamel Shapes (141678), Pearl Basic Jewels (144219), Foam Adhesive Strips (141825), Dimensionals (104430) Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309), Fast Fuse (129026)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1 – To make the sled: use the Wood Crate die to cut two pieces



2 – Using scissors, trim the top bar off of the first...



3 - And then the top bar and end panel on the second...



4 – Fold along all score lines and apply adhesive tape to the flaps...




5 – Fold up and secure in place...



6 – <u>To make the dog</u>: take the reindeer die from Santa's Sleigh Thinlits and die cut a piece of brown cardstock...





10 –Cut off the bottom panel and the end panel and adhere in place – I used glue dots at the top of the end panel and sloped it for a more realistic look...



11 – Now you are going to give the sled a little lift – add three Foam Adhesive Strips to the bottom – be sure not to take the covering off of the exposed side – you don't want it to stick to your surface...



12 – And here you can see that it is slightly elevated from the surface...



13 – To make your sled runners, cut two strips of Silver Foil Paper measuring $4'' \ge 1/4''$ and trim one of the ends on an angle...



14 – Use glue dots to attach to the bottom of your sled...



15 – Now you are going to attach your dogs to lines – to do this you can either cut straight thin strips or die cut shaped strips of Thick Whisper White cardstock – I used a die from Popcorn Box Thinlits to create the wavy lines...



16 – Attach the lines of the dogs closest to the sled to the front panel using glue dots – and the other end behind each dog...



17 – And then take a line from each dog to the front dog...



You can cover the front panel with a piece of $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 1" cardstock to hide where those lines attach.

18 – For the accessories – I cut the trees using another die from Santa's Sleigh Thinlits (from Dazzling Diamonds Glimmer Paper & Garden Green cardstock) and secured them to the back of the sled using Dimensionals. I stamped the image and using my paper trimmer to shape it...



And I stamped the person & colored him in using Markers in the colors Marina Mist, Early Espresso, Crumb Cake and Pink Pirouette and used Dazzling Diamonds Glitter to add sparkle to the furry bits
