

## WASHI TAPE HOLDER

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## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Colorful Seasons
- Inks: Old Olive,
- Cardstock: Whisper White, Rich Razzleberry, Lemon Lime Twist, Smoky Slate
- Designer Paper: Pick A Pattern, Delightful Daisy
- Accessories: Pumpkin Pie Stitched-Edge Ribbon
- Tools: Pretty Label Punch, Seasonal Layers Thinlits Dies, Washi Tape, Stampin' Dimensionals, Tear & Tape
- Miscellaneous: Empty Wax Paper Box

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**



1. Using an empty wax paper box, carefully remove the cutting edge. You may want to wear gloves so you don't cut yourself.



2. Unassemble the box to lay flat.



3. Cut a piece of the Pick A Pattern Designer Paper to measure 12" x 10". Add Tear & Tape to each section of the box near the fold lines on each side all the way across. Remove the backing from the Tear & Tape one section at a time and press the designer paper in place and fold on the fold line. The designer paper should be positioned so the 10" side is horizontal. Move to the next section and repeat until all sections are glued and folded. Trim the end if needed.



4. On both sides of the box, cut off the longest tab as shown in the photo. Glue a piece of the Delightful Daisy Designer Paper on each end. Due to the variation in boxes, you'll have to measure from the Pick A Pattern Designer Paper to the end of the longest tab. Trim to fit as shown. All but the two small tabs should be covered. Repeat on both ends. Add Tear & Tape to the 2 small tabs.




5. Using the Pretty Label Punch and Whisper White Cardstock, cut (4) and add a score line in the center of each. Fold on the score line.



6. Glue a punched shape to each corner, centered. Trim excess at each corner at the top and bottom.



7. Add Tear & Tape around the whole box where the two designer papers meet. Repeat on the other side also. Remove backing and press the ribbon in place around all four sides and on both ends of the box. Trim the ends. This is what your box should now look like:





- 8. Using the stamp set and the framelits, stamp and cut the following:
- a. (1) die-cut leaf in Lemon Lime Twist Cardstock
- b. (2) die-cut leaves in Rich Razzleberry Cardstock
- c. (4) die-cut skinny branches using Smoky Slate Cardstock
- d. (2) large stamped leaves using Basic Black & Pumpkin Pie Inks.
- e. (4) small stamped leaves using Old Olive Ink. Stamp twice without reinking to get the two lighter shades.

Layer and glue all of the stamped and die-cut layers on the front of the box and to the left-hand side.

Fill the box with Washi Tape and your project is complete!
