

## Petal Garden Gold Foil Rose Card



### Supplies:

**Stamp:** One Big Meaning (CM 139420/WM 138788)

**Cardstocks:** Very Vanilla (101650), Pool Party (122924)

**DSP:** Wood Textures (144177)

**Punch** 1 1/4" Circle (119861)

**Ink:** Early Espresso (126974)

**Memories & More:** Petal Garden Card Pack (144208)

**Ribbons:** Very Vanilla 1/2" Lace Trim (141672), Pool Party 3/8" Shimmer (144152), Vanilla Bakers Twine (144224)

**Misc:** Brights Enamel Shapes (141680), Subtles Enamel Shapes (141679), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

### Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Very Vanilla 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"
- Blue layer: Pool Party 5 1/8" x 3 7/8"
- Brown layer: Wood Textures DSP 5" x 3 3/4"

### Instructions:

1. Cut the piece of Wood Texture DSP to size and adhere to the Pool Party layer - carefully pop out the gold foil die cut rose (you will find it in the Memories & More Petal Garden Card Pack) and use the Fine Tip Glue Pen to dot adhesive onto the back of it and add to the wood paper
2. Wrap around a piece of Very Vanilla Lace Trim and attach to the Very Vanilla card base
3. Wrap around a piece of Very Vanilla Bakers Twine over to top layers and secure using tape inside the card
4. Peel the 'beautiful' sticker from the backing paper and add to the top of the card front
5. Stamp the word 'You' and punch out using the Circle Punch
6. Cut a small piece of Pool Party Shimmer Ribbon and add on top of the ribbons on the right side
7. Use Dimensionals to add the punched circle on top
8. Cut two more pieces of Shimmer Ribbon and fold in half – use tape to hold their ends together – position one on top of the other in a staggered formation and use a Mini Glue Dot to hold their position – tuck under the punched circle and secure in place with another Glue Dot
9. Add Old Olive and Daffodil Delight enamel dots around the rose and a Calypso Coral Heart under the circle.
