

Birthday Card featuring Colorful Candles & an Overlay



Supplies:

Stamp: Merry Patterns Host (144973)

Cardstocks: Berry Burst (144243), Basic Black (121045), Whisper White (100730)

Embossing Folder: Polka Dot Basics (143709)

Die Cutting: Happy Birthday Thinlits (143700), Layering Ovals (141706), Big Shot (143263)

Inks: Berry Burst (144083), Bermuda Bay (131171), Daffodil Delight (126944), Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Clear Wink of Stella Glitter Brush (141897)

Ribbon & Twine: Whisper White 3/8" Classic Weave (144159), Whisper White Solid Bakers (124262)

Misc: Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Berry Burst 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" - scored at 4 1/4"
- Layers: Basic Black 5 1/4" x 4", Whisper White 5 1/8" x 3 7/8"

Instructions:

1. Cut the White layer and texture using the Polka Dot Basics Embossing Folder – adhere to the Black layer and then to the Berry Burst layer
2. Wrap around a piece of Whisper White Classic Weave Ribbon
3. Use stamps from Merry Patterns to stamp the candle images and cut out using a die from Layering Ovals – attach over the ribbon using a Dimensional
4. Tie three pieces of Whisper White Solid Bakers Twine along the ribbon to create a ruched effect – one at each end of the oval tag and one at the other end
5. Use the Happy Birthday Thinlits die to cut Happy Birthday from Black cardstock and add to the card using pieces of Dimensionals that you cut into narrow strips
6. And there you have a beautiful card ready for giving – you can easily turn this into a masculine card simply by changing the ink colors and base cardstock color 😊
