Supplies:

Stamps: Brightly Lit Christmas (144807), Window Shopping (CM 143265/WM 142920)

Bundle: Brightly Lit Christmas Photopolymer (146040)

Die Cutting: Christmas Lamppost Thinlits (144675), Welcome Home Framelits (143752), Stitched Shapes Framelits

(145372), Big Shot (143263)

Cardstocks: Soft Suede (115318), Lemon Lime Twist (144245), Berry Burst (144243), Powder Pink (144244), Whisper

White (100730)

Ink: Lemon Lime Twist (144086), Soft Suede (126978)

Ribbon & Twine: Berry Burst 1/2" Finely Woven (144133), Whisper White Solid Bakers (124262)

Misc: Rhinestone Jewels (144220), Mini Dimensionals (144108), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309), Mini Glue Dots (103683),

Snail (104332)

Cutting Measurements:

Card base: Soft Suede 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"

Layers: Lemon Lime Twist 4" x 5 1/4", Berry Burst 3 7/8" x 5 1/8", Whisper White 3 5/8" x 3 4 7/8"

Instructions:

- 1. Cut the Lemon Lime Twist, Berry Burst and Whisper White layers and adhere them all together
- 2. Stamp a bunch of Lemon Lime Twist wreaths using a stamp from Brightly Lit Christmas and cut out using the coordinating die from Christmas Lamppost Thinlits adhere them in place on the white layer
- 3. Stamp Happy Birthday using a stamp from Window Shopping and cut out using a die from Stitched Shapes Framelits and add to the layer
- 4. Wrap around a piece of Berry Burst Finely Woven Ribbon and secure with tape on the back of the Lemon Lime Twist layer adhere all of the layers to the Soft Suede card base
- 5. Add another wreath just below the ribbon using Mini Dimensionals you can use some White Bakers Twine to 'hang' it onto the ribbon like I did or you can skip this step it looks great either way!
- 6. Make a bow and add to the ribbon using a glue dot
- 7. Use the small flower die from Welcome Home Framelits to cut out a bunch of colorful flowers and add them to the wreaths using glue. Pop a sparkly Rhinestone Jewel into the center of each and you are done ©
