

## Christmas Cheer Ornament Card



### Supplies:

**Memories & More:** Merry Little Christmas Card Pack (144638)

**Die Cutting:** Card Front Builder Thinlits (144674), Big Shot (143263)

**Embossing Folder:** Quilt Top (144687)

**Punch:** Holly Berry Builder (141843)

**Cardstocks:** Silver Foil (132178), Fresh Fig (144242), Lemon Lime Twist (144245), Soft Suede (115318), Whisper White (100730)

**Ribbons:** Fresh Fig 1/8" Sheer (144174), Silver Mini Sequin Trim (144230)

**Misc:** Brights Enamel Shapes (141680), Paper Snips (103579), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail (104332)

### Cutting Measurements:

- Card base: Soft Suede 4 ¼" x 11" - scored at 5 ½"
- Layers: Silver Foil 5 ¼" x 4", Fresh Fig 5 1/8" x 3 7/8", Whisper White 5" x 3 ¾"

### Instructions:

1. Cut the Silver Foil layer and adhere to the Soft Suede card base. Use the Quilt Top Embossing Folder to texture the Fresh Fig layer and put to one side
2. Cut the White layer – take the two acetate pieces from the Merry Little Christmas Card Pack and cut the Christmas Cheer to fit the white layer – use pieces of Mini Glue Dots to adhere it in place – if you pop the glue dots under the silver words they won't show through
3. Cut out the ornament using sharp scissors and add to the layer
4. Use the ornament dies from Card Front Builder Thinlits to cut small ornaments and add them with glue dots
5. Attach the white layer to the fig layer and then wrap around a piece of Fresh Fig 1/8" Sheer Ribbon with a piece of Silver Mini Sequin Trim above that – once taped in place, add to the card base
6. Use the Holly Berry Builder Punch to cut the leaves from Lemon Lime Twist and add a couple of Pumpkin Pie Enamel Dots for the berries
7. And there you have one pretty and elegant Holiday card ready for giving 😊
