Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Sure Do Love You (wood) 145763 (clear) 145766 and Heart Happiness 145769
- Inks: Rich Razzleberry 126950, Calypso Coral 126983, Melon Mambo 126948
- Cardstock: Rich Razzleberry 115316, Whisper White 100730, Gold Foil Sheets 132622
- Designer Paper: Painted With Love 145580
- Tools: Simple Score Scoring Tool 122334, Tear & Tape 138995, Lots To Love Box Framelits Dies 145653, Ticket Tear Border Punch 143718
- Miscellaneous: Velcro Dots, Pencil, Ruler

INSTRUCTIONS:

Please use the following pattern for all scoring:

Triangle Box Template

Designer Paper 7-1/2" x 7-1/2". Score at 2-1/2" & 5"

1. Using the Painted With Love Designer Paper, cut a piece measuring 7-1/2" x 7-1/2". Score at 2-1/2" and 5" vertically and horizontally. Once your score lines are in place, score an "X" in all four scored corner boxes:



- Using a ruler, mark the center squares on two opposing sides only with a tick mark in the center, use this tick mark to score a "V" in each square as shown on the pattern:



- Score and fold on all score lines so your box looks like this:



- As you squeeze and pinch the sides, your box will close like this:



5. Cut a 2nd piece of designer paper to measure 4-3/4" x 2-1/2". Score at 2-1/2" & 2-3/4" and fold on score lines. This is the flap portion of the box:



6. Add Tear & Tape to the underside of the larger side of the flap like this:



7. Glue to the back of the box and add a Velcro dot to the front of the flap on the underside. Fold flap over and press the 2nd part of the Velcro dot in place:



8. This is what the box should look like once the flap is glued in place and folded over to secure with the Velcro dot:



9. Stamp the following pieces using the two stamp sets and the inks. Cut out with the coordinating dies. For the large sentiment heart, I sponged both ink colors on the stamp image. Cut a Whisper White Cardstock square to measure 2-1/4" x 2-1/4" and stamp as shown:



10. Use the Ticket Tear Border Punch to cut a small sliver of Rich Razzleberry Cardstock to glue under the flap:



11. Glue the stamped square to the center of the inside of the box:



12. Decorate the front of your box. All layers are glued flat:
