

Calendar Easel Card



Supplies:

Stamps: Flying Home (CM 145929/WM 145926)

Cardstocks: Whisper White (100730), Soft Suede (115318), Calypso Coral (122925), Pool Party (122924)

Die Cutting & Embossing: Simple Stripes EF (145648), Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Big Shot (143263)

Scoring: Simply Scored (122334)

Punch: 3/4" Circle (119873)

Ink: Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

Blends Markers: Bronze (144607), Crumb Cake Light (144582), Calypso Coral Combo Pack (144045), Pool Party Combo Pack (144605), Daffodil Light (144586), Old Olive Light (144574), Rich Razzleberry Combo Pack (144602)

Ribbon: Crumb Cake 3/8 Classic Weave (144162)

Misc: Vippiies Large Calendar Pad, Dimensionals (104430), Snail (104332), Fast Fuse (129026)

Cutting Measurements:

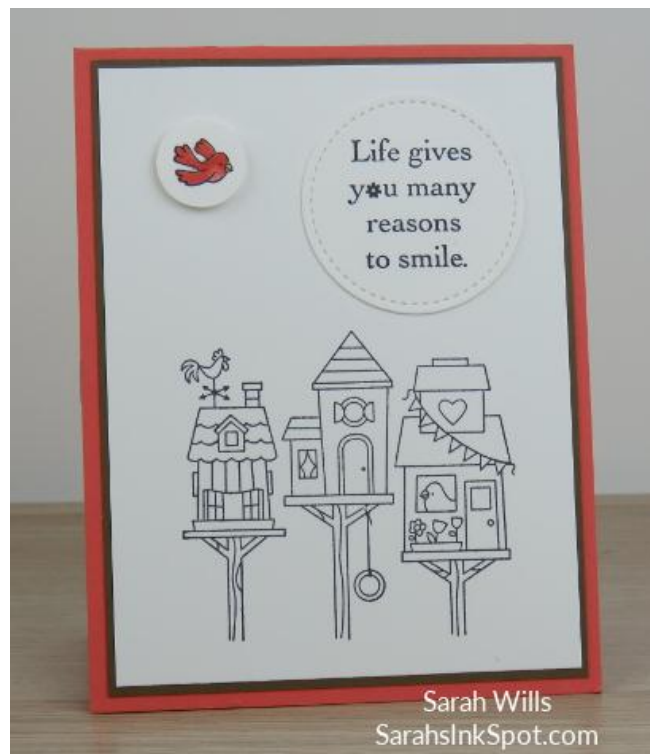
- Card base: colored cardstock cut to be 4 1/4" x 11" - scored at 5 1/2"
- Easel insert section: same color as the card base, cut to be 4" x 4"
- Cut layers as desired – I used Soft Suede 4" x 5 1/4" & Whisper White 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"
- White embossed panel behind calendar – 2 1/4" x 3 7/8"

Instructions:

1. Stamp and color your images onto the White layer
2. Assemble your layers and use an embossing folder to texture a panel to put behind the calendar if desired
3. Adhere layers to the card base and wrap around a piece of ribbon, securing on the back of the card front
4. Fold card in half and adhere the calendar pad in place
5. Cut your easel insert section to be 4x4 and score at 1/2", 2" and 3 1/2" – fold along the 2" score line to fold the piece in half.
6. Fold the two end tabs the opposite way – apply strong adhesive tape to the outside edge of each and attach to each side of the inside of the card base right at the bottom...



7. Decorate the back panel as desired using stamps, papers, an inspirational quote, a handwritten note – or leave blank – entirely up to you 😊
