



Tealight Cake w/Matching Box

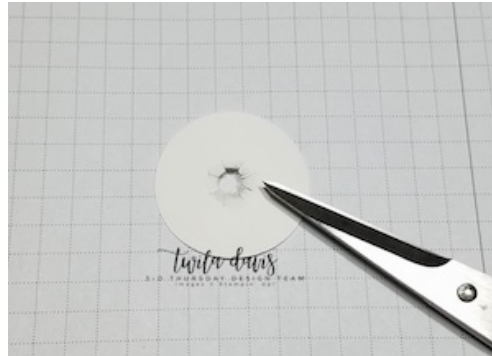
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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Party Pandas (Sale-A-Bartion)
- Inks: Bermuda Bay
- Cardstock (CS): Bermuda Bay, Whisper White, Peekaboo Peach
- Designer Paper: Picture Perfect Party 6" x 6" DSP
- Accessories: Window Sheet, Multipurpose Glue, Glue Dots, Dimensionals, Pearl Basic Jewels, Whisper White 1/4" Organza Ribbon
- Tools: Big Shot, Garden Trellis Emboss Folder, Layering Circle Framelits, Layering Square Framelits, 1 3/8" Circle Punch, 1/2" Circle Punch, Tree Builder Punch, Stampin' Trimmer, Simply Scored Scoring Tool, Stampin' Pierce Mat, Paper Snips, Light Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blend
- Miscellaneous: Tealight, Cropadile

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Birthday Cake - Punch a circle using Whisper White CS and the 1 3/8" Circle Punch. Find the center of the circle and punch a hole. (I used the Cropadile.) Using Paper Snips make little snips all the way around the center punched out circle, making it easier to slip over the tealight candle.



2. Cut a piece of Whisper White CS 5 1/2 x 2 1/2". Run through the Big Shot using the Garden Trellis Emboss Folder. Cut down to 5 1/4" x (a wide) 5/8".



3. Glue circle and long white band around the tealight.



4. Using the Big Shot and the fourth from the smallest Scallop Circle Framelit cut a Peakaboo Peach Scallop Circle. Punch a 1/2" Circle so that the On-Off Switch shows through. Add the circle to the bottom of the tealight using Dimensionals.



5. Punch out 12 little flowers using the Tree Builder Punch and a scrap of Bermuda Bay CS. Using the Scoring Tool and Paper Piercing Mat press down in the center of each flower.



6. Add glue dots to the back of the flowers and attach six around the tealight flame and (3) groups of two flowers around the base of the tealight. Color little pearls with the Stampin' Blends and add to the middle of the flowers. Now the tealight cake is done.



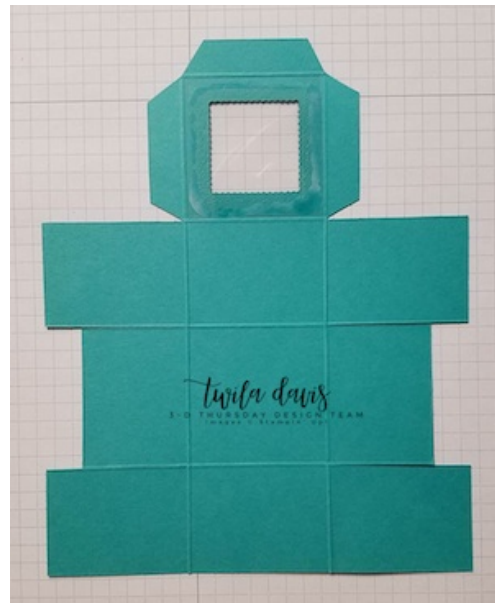
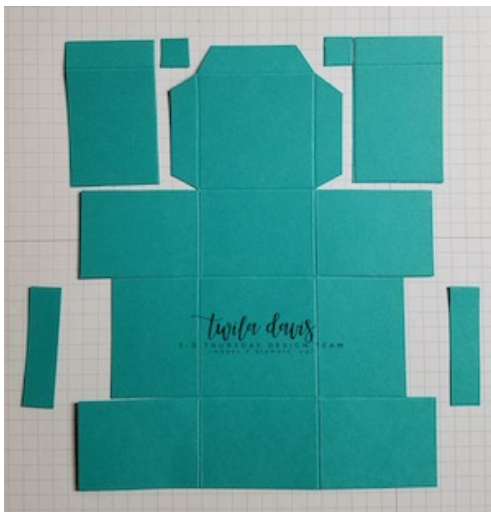
7. Cake Box - Cut a piece of Bermuda Bay CS at 7 1/2" x 6". On the horizontal side score CS at 1/2", 2 1/2", 4", and 6".



8. Portrait side score at 1 1/2" and 4 1/2" to the second horizontal score line. Score at 2" and 4" all the way down.



9. Trim away sides as shown. Cut short sides of box top at angles. Also trim 1/2" from 2" square side pieces. Using the second biggest Scallop Square Framelit and Big Shot cut a window out of the top of box as shown. Cut a short 2" Window Sheet and glue to the inside of the window of box.



10. Fold up sides of box and glue together. Cut (2) 1" x 5 1/2" pieces of Picture Perfect Party DSP and attach to the sides of the box overlapping the ends of each strip.



11. Cut a strip of Whisper White CS 1/2" x 2 1/2". Stamp Happy Birthday using the stamp from the Party Pandas Stamp Set and Bermuda Bay Ink. Using the Banner Punch punch the end of the strip. Using (2) 20" strips of the Whisper White Organza Ribbon tie around the box in a bow. Slip the banner underneath the bow attaching with a glue dot. Now the box is done.
