



Sliding Door Easter Treat Box

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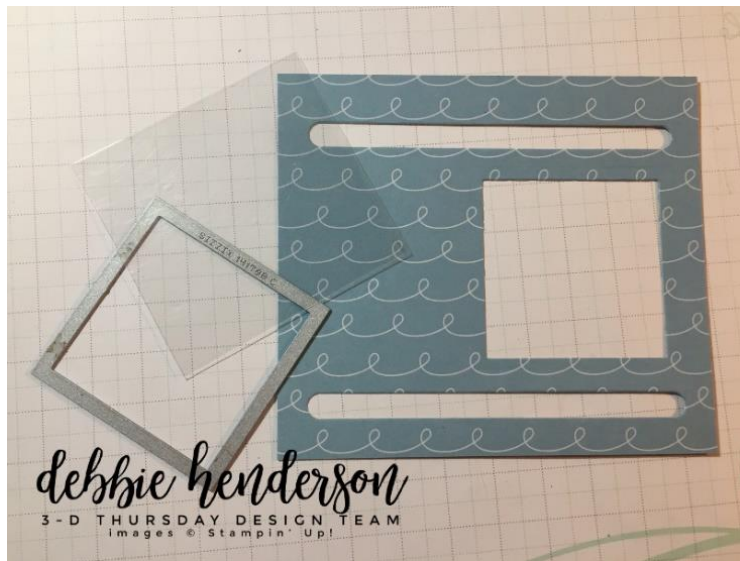
Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Barn Door (145865) (145862), You're Inspiring (145808) (145805)
- Inks: Early Espresso (126974) Melon Mambo & Daffodil Delight Stampin' Write Markers (131259)
- Cardstock: Marina Mist (119682), Lemon Lime Twist (144245), So Saffron (105118), Wisteria Wonder (122922), Early Espresso (119686), Whisper White (100730)
- Designer Paper: Sweet Soiree (145564), Fresh Florals (144131)
- Accessories: Lemon Lime Twist ½" Finely Woven Ribbon (144135)
- Tools: Sliding Door Framelits Dies (145662), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108), Window Sheets (142314), Tear & Tape (138995) Picnic Basket Builder Framelits Dies (145658), Layering Squares Dies (141708)
- Miscellaneous: (4) Pennies, Easter Treats

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut a piece of the designer paper to measure 4-1/2" x 4". Cut the track for the door using the dies leaving 1/2" at the top. Cut a square using the Layering Squares Die measuring 1-7/8" x 1-7/8" on the right-hand side as shown in the photo.

Cut a Window Sheet to measure 2-1/4" x 2-1/4":



2. Add Tear & Tape on the backside around the square hole for the Window Sheet. Remove backing and press the Window Sheet in place:



3. Cut a piece of Whisper White Cardstock to measure 2" x 2". Cut the long piece of grass with the die from the Picnic Basket Dies using Lemon Lime Twist Cardstock. Glue to the bottom of the white layer. Stamp the Easter sentiment using Early Espresso Ink. Glue in place on the front of the designer paper next to the hole for the Window Sheet and glue the grass over the Window Sheet. Place the door where it needs to go, centered over the tracks:



4. Flip the designer paper over, holding the door in place and add (4) Mini Stampin' Dimensionals in the tracks as shown. Press the (4) pennies in place:

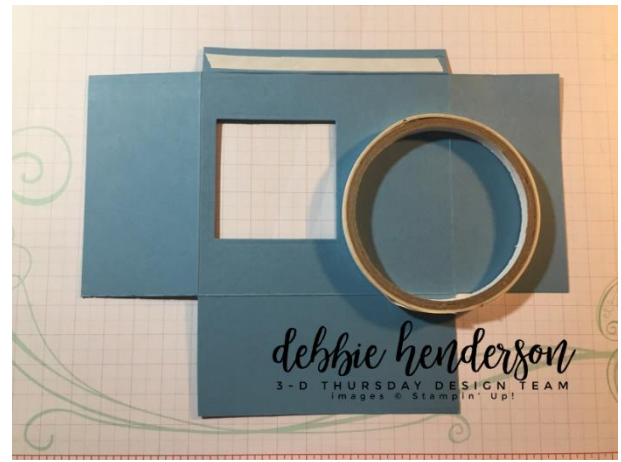


5. Cut (2) pieces of Marina Mist Cardstock to measure 6-1/2" x 8-1/2". On the 8-1/2" side, score at 2" & 4-1/2". On the 6-1/2" side, score at 1/2" & 4-1/2". Cut off each corner as shown in the photo for both pieces. Fold on all score lines.

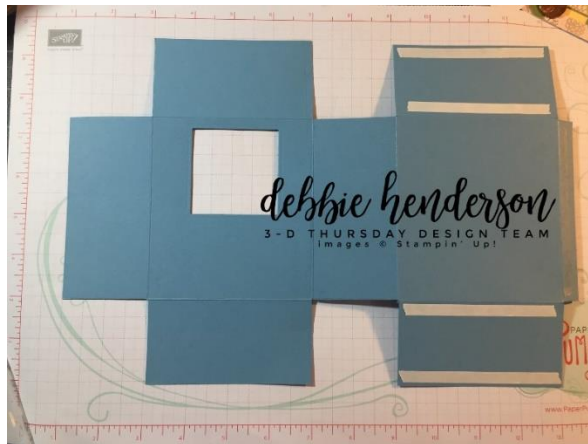
Cut a square with the die measuring 2-1/8" x 2-1/8" (cut the hole so it is going to overlap over the hole in the designer paper):



6. Add Tear & Tape to both pieces as shown in the photos below:



7. Remove the backing from the Tear & Tape and glue both pieces to each other as shown in the photo by overlapping the large tabs and then glue the sides together by overlapping the tabs (do not glue the top pieces together):



8. Cut a piece Fresh Florals Designer Paper (lemon lime twist) to measure $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " and press in place on the small flap at the top:



9. Add Stampin' Dimensionals to the door layer as shown (do not add dimensionals over the top and bottom of the tracks so the door can slide). Glue to the front of the box:



10. Add Tear & Tape around the two sides and bottom of the box. Cut a piece of ribbon 24- $\frac{1}{2}$ " and glue the ribbon to all three sides keeping 12" on each end that will be used to tie into a bow at the top:



11. Add treats to the inside of the box and tie ribbon at the top into a bow. This will keep the top closed:



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
