



A Truck Full Of Eggs

Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: We Must Celebrate
- Inks: Memento Black
- Cardstock: Lemon Lime Twist, Tempting Turquoise, Whisper White, Basic Black Daffodil Delight
- Accessories:
- Tools: Paper Trimmer, Simply Scored Scoring Tool, Paper Snips, 1 1/4", 3/4, 1/2", Circle Punches, Ticket Tear Border Punch
- Miscellaneous: Bronze, Light Smokey Slate, Ivory Stampin' Blends, Tear Tape, Dimensionals, Piece of Cardboard Backing from a pack of Foil Sheets. Chocolate Easter Eggs (Hershey Brand Eggs are too small)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Truck Cab -

Cut a piece of CS 6" x 7". Scoring on the short side. First lay a scrap of CS at the 1" line. Score at 5/8", 1 3/8", 4 5/8" and 5 3/8". Remove scrap and score all the way down at 2" and 4".



2. Turn and score at 1 3/4", 3 3/4", 5 3/4" and 6 3/8".





3. Using Black Memento Ink, stamp the bunny from the "group of animal" onto a piece of Whisper White CS. Using the Stampin' Blends color the bunny and cut it out. Cut a 1" x 1 3/4" piece of Tempting Turquoise CS. Score at 1" on the long side. Fold and attach the bunny to the (back of seat) by adding (2) Dimensionals to his back and (1) under and (1) on top of his lap, attaching the bottom one to the seat. The top one will attach to the truck in the next step.



4. Cut out Cab as shown. Add Tear Tape as shown. Add the bunny with or without seat at this time. Using the Ticket Tear Punch, punch the other end off the cab top.



5. Start folding and attaching the cab together as shown. Using a glue dot to glue down the roof of cab.




6. Truck Bed -

Cut a piece of Tempting Turquoise CS 3 1/2" x 4 1/2". Score at 3/4" all the way around. Cut in to where the scorelines cross as shown on the ends and add Tear Tape.



7. Removable Bed Topper -

Cut a piece of Tempting Turquoise Cs 2 3/4" x 3 3/4". On Back horizontal side using a pen or pencil, draw lines at 1 3/8" and 2 3/8". On the long side at 1 3/8". In the middle of the squares mark a small line at 7/8", 1 7/8" and 2 7/8". On the long side 7/8" and 1 7/8". Using the 3/4" Circle Punch, Punch out (6) holes. Cut in to where the scorelines cross and add Tear Tape.



8. Fold up and make your box and removable top.



9. Cut a piece of cardboard a small 2" x 5". Attach the cab and bed on top of it with Tombo Glue.



10. Tires -

Using the 1 1/4" Circle Punch, punch out (8) Basic Black circles and (4) cardboard circles. Attach the a black circle to each side of the (4) cardboard circles. Punch out (4) 3/4" circles using the 3/4" Circle Punch and attach to the tires with dimensional. Glue tires to the sides of the truck. Add headlights to the truck by punching out (2) 1/2" circles of Daffodil Delight CS and attach to the front of truck using Dimensionals. Add chocolate eggs and your truck is finished. The topper can also be removed to hold more eggs or other treat.



13. Your "Truck Full Of Eggs" is now complete.
