



## Red Wagon Seed Packet Holder

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### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

**Stamps:** Tabs for Everything (143907), Happy Birthday Gorgeous (143662)

**Die Cutting:** Wood Crate Framelits (143730), Coffee Cups Framelits (143745), Pocket Framelits (143750), Big Shot (143263)

**Punches:** 1" Circle (119868), 1/2" Circle (119869)

**Cardstocks:** Real Red (102482), Basic Black (121045), Whisper White (100730)

**Ink:** Garden Green (126973), Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)

**Ribbons:** Garden Green 3/8" Stitched Satin (144181), Whisper White Solid Bakers Twine (124262)

**Embellishments:** Metallic Enamel Shapes (141678), Gold Binder Clips (141673), Touches of Nature Elements (144216), Brights Enamel Shapes (141680)

**Adhesives:** Tear & Tape (138995), Mini Dimensionals (144108), Snail (104332), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1 – Take the Wood Crate die and cut two shapes from Real Red cardstock...



2 - Fold along all score lines and apply strong adhesive tape to the end tabs on each piece – do not remove the backing paper just yet...



3 – Apply regular adhesive to one of the rectangle bottom pieces, line up & adhere the other on top...



4 – Fold in the tabs, remove the backing paper and adhere in place...



5 – Cut four circles out of black cardstock using the 1" Circle Punch...



6 – Cut four circles out of white cardstock using the 1/2" Circle Punch...



7 – Use Mini Dimensionals to attach each white disc in place...



8 – Cut the handle pieces using either your paper trimmer & scissors OR dies from Coffee Cups Framelits and Pocket Framelits. Attach the handle to the underside of the box with tape and adhere the end piece to the other end using a Mini Glue Dot...



9 – Attach the wheels using Mini Dimensionals and you are all ready to fill & decorate!
