



## Stamp Case Organizer

### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Coffee Cafe
- Inks: Early Espresso, Garden Green
- Cardstock: Garden Green, Pear Pizazz, scrap of Whisper White
- Designer Paper: Coffee Break
- Accessories: Pear Pizazz Shimmer Ribbon, Linen Thread, Corrugated Elements
- Tools: Paper Trimmer, Envelope Maker, Big Shot, Coffee Cups Framelits Dies, 1/16" Hole Punch, Scissors,
- Miscellaneous: Standard Stamp Case, Tear Tape, Multipurpose Liquid Glue, 5" X 8" Notepad, RSVP Pen, 2 1/4" x 3" Calendar, 5" X 8" Notepad, (3) Velcro 5/8" Dots

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut (2) 4" x 7" Coffee Break DSP, cut (1) coordinating 3 1/2" x 7" Coffee Break DSP. Add Tear Tape to the back of the coordinating DSP on both long sides. Attach it by overlapping it 3/8" to one of the 4" x 7" Coffee Break and then to the other side overlapping it the same. Trim from both sides until the full measurement of the combined papers is 10 9/16". (Measurement may vary.) Add (2) 3/8" x 7" Pear Pizazz strip along each side of the middle strip using Tear Tape to adhere it.



2. Slide the finished cover between the Stamp Case and the Plastic Sleeve.



3. Cut the Notepad down to 5" x 7 1/8" using scissors or paper trimmer. Cut a piece of Garden Green CS to 5" x 9". Score at 1 1/2", 1 3/4" & 2 5/8". (Scorelines may vary due to the black lip of your notepad.) Attach the CS to the back, and front black lip. Cut a piece of coordinating DSP at 2 1/2" x 5". Cut (2) pieces of Pear Pizazz at 3/8" x 5". Add Tear Tape to the backsides. Add the DSP piece to the front cover at 3 1/4". Then attach the Pear Pizazz strips to the top and bottom of the DSP piece.



4. Cut a piece of Garden Green CS 1 1/2" x (a short) 5". Glue this to the inside top right side of the Stamp Case using the Multipurpose Liquid Glue.



5. Attach (2) Velcro Dots (front and back pieces) to back side of Notepad as shown in picture. Lay the Notepad down on top of the strip that was glued down to the inside of Stamp Case. Pressing firmly to adhere Velcro Dots in place to the strip.



6. Cut a piece of Coffee Break DSP to 3 1/4" x 2 1/2" and adhere the Calendar to it. Using the Envelope Maker and a 6" x 6" piece of Coffee Break DSP make a Envelope for a 3" x 4" card. Use a Velcro Dot for the closure.



7. Attach the Calendar and the Envelope to the inside left of the Stamp Case as shown using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.



8. Cut a 7/8" x 3 1/2" strip of matching DSP. Unscrew the cap off of a RSVP pen and take the ink tube out. Roll the strip of DSP around the ink tube tightly. Slide it off and then slide the roll of DSP up into the barrel of the ink pen. Put ink tube back in and screw cap back on.



9. Stamp the small heart in Garden Green CS onto a scrap of Whisper White CS and using the Big Shot and tiny Tag Framelit cut it out. Stamp the word Friend (from the bottom of the sentiment stamp) in Early Espresso on a piece of 3/4" x 2 1/2" piece of Pear Pizazz CS. Trim end to make a tag and using the 1/16" hole punch, punch a hole at the trimmed end. Combine this two little tags with a tag from the Corrugated Elements with a piece of Linen Thread. Make a bow with more of the Linen Thread and tie to your tags. Wrap a piece of Pear Pizazz Shimmer Ribbon around the finished case and tie in a bow adding your cluster of little tags to it.



10. Your Organizer is now complete and ready for gift giving.
