Die Cutting: Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372), Layering Ovals Framelits (141706), Big Shot (143263) Tools: Envelope Punch Board (133774)

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

To make the outer Envelope Box – Cut a piece of cardstock to measure 11 1/8" square...



Place in your Envelope Punch Board and punch & score at  $4 \frac{1}{8''}$  – move your paper along and repeat at 6  $\frac{1}{4''}$  (to do this you will need to pop a ruler on the left side as the measurements only go up to 5'') – be careful as you score as your paper is larger than the board...



Rotate your cardstock 90 degrees and line up the pointed bit of the punch with the first score line...



Punch & score and repeat at the second score line – because of the size of your cardstock the score line might not extend up to your pointy bit – use a ruler to extend that line to guide you to line up perfectly




Repeat for the other two sides, fold along all score lines, cut the flaps and this is what you will have...



Apply adhesive and assemble your envelope box & decorate as wished...







And use strong adhesive tape to assemble...



Use patterned papers to cover your front & back chipboard pieces and and use a strong hole punch such as the Crop-a-dile to make two holes to thread your binder rings through on the first cover – use that as a guide to create the holes on your other cover and your pages. Here are my covers & pages – as you can see I used patterned papers to make my Envelope Pages rather than cardstock...



**To make the Envelope Page Inserts** – Cut cardstock or patterned papers to be 5 5/8" x 3 3/4" and make a hole in the top to thread through ribbon to make it easy to pull them out – here are examples of mine – the insert is on the left...



This is how I decorated – all items that I used are listed in the supply list at the top of this Project Sheet:



Here is how I decorated the outer box...





Here is a small pocket on the inside of the front cover...
