

## **New Home Gift Box**

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## Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamps: Pop On By (146641), At Home With You (143681), Seasoned with Kindness (146804)

Die Cutting: Pop-Up House Thinlits (146829), Bunch of Banners Framelits (141488), Big Shot (143263)

BUNDLE: Pop On By (148377)

Box: Lustrous White Mini Gable Boxes (146961)

Tools: Paper Snips (103579) Punch: Classic Label (141491)

Cardstocks: Coastal Cabana (131297), Basic Gray (121044), Whisper White (100730), So Saffron (105118), Calypso Coral (122925), Old Olive (100702), Vellum (101856)

Ink: Crushed Curry (147087), Memento Tuxedo Black (132708), Calypso Coral Light Stampin' Blends Marker (144042), Crumb Cake Light Stampin' Blends Marker (144582)

Ribbon & Twine: Bermuda Bay 1/4" Mini Striped (146939), Nature's Twine (146342), Silver Bakers Twine (145569)

Embellies: Metallic Brads (146929), Share What You Love Artisan Pearls (146927)

Adhesives: Dimensionals (104430), Mini Dimensionals (144108), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Snail

(104332), Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309)

1 – Use the house die from Pop-Up House Thinlits to cut your house shape from whatever cardstock color you choose – for this tutorial I used white for easy viewing...



2 – Use Paper Snips to trim away the side pieces and if you wish to have a 'lawn' out front make sure you add enough cardstock at the bottom before die cutting to shape it as I did below. Alternatively you can cut that bottom section off along the lines if you prefer no garden bit in the front...



3 – Take a white Gable Box and assemble – use one of the wide top flaps as a template to cut a piece of cardstock the same color as your roof is going to be – for me, it is Basic Gray...



4 – And adhere to one of those top panels with Snail adhesive...



5 – Use the front panel of the box as a template to cut a piece of cardstock in the same color as your house front – mine is Coastal Cabana – and adhere in place...



6 – Use the stamps & dies the Pop On By Bundle to stamp & cut all of the pieces for the front of your house and adhere in place...



7 – And adhere in place over that front panel – bend your roof piece back slightly and it will sit in place nicely...



Add your finishing touches, the gift or card inside and it is ready for gifting!

Here is my finished box – all supplies that I used are detailed in the supply list...



I added a tab to the back of the flower box so that it stands up...



And here is a close up of the ribbons & twine...
