Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Inks: Soft Suede Classic Stampin' Pad [147115], Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker [100082], Bronze Stampin' Blend [144607]
- Cardstock: Soft Suede 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock [115318], Crumb Cake 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock [120953], Basic Black 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock [121045], Whisper White 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock [100730]
- Accessories: Berry Burst 3/8" Metallic-Edge Ribbon [145489]
- Tools: Layering Ovals Framelits Dies [141706], 1-1/4" Circle Punch [119861], 3/4" Circle Punch [119873], Paper Snips [103579]
- Miscellaneous: Pizza Boxes [144645], Sponge Daubers [133773]

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Use the Bronze Stampin' Blend marker to color a pizza box.

2. Add a 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" Soft Suede Card Stock square to the top of the pizza box.

3. Using the Layering Ovals Framelits Dies cut two (2) large ovals with Basic Black Card Stock for the ears and one (1) with Crumb Cake Card Stock for the mouth. Also cut one (1) small oval with Basic Black Card Stock for the nose.

4. Using a Sponge Dauber ink the edges of the Crumb Cake Card Stock oval with Soft Suede ink.

5. Using Paper Snips shape the Basic Black ovals to make ears, score and then adhere them to the sides of the pizza box with Snail adhesive.

6. Using the 1-1/4" Circle Punch cut two (2) Whisper White circles for the eyes and one (1) Soft Suede for the eye lids. Use Paper Snips to cut the Soft Suede circle in half.

7. Using the 3/4" Circle Punch cut two (2) Basic Black circles for the pupils.

8. Use Dimensionals to build the eyes and adhere to the top of the pizza box.

9. Use a Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker to draw on a mouth and eyelashes.

10. Tie a bow with Berry Burst 3/8" Metallic-Edge Ribbon and add to the box.
